PROCUREMENT SUBJECT: SUPPLY OF ICT EQUIPMENTS AND ITS INSTALLATION (SERVER), RENOVATION OF COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT OFFICES IN LOPA/LAFON AND BUDI FOR NPA/MDTF EASTERN EQUATORIA STATE PROJECT.

1. The Government of Republic of South Sudan has received a grant from the Multi Donor Trust Funds (MDTF) (hereinafter referred to as "Grant") towards the cost of the "Basic packages for Health Services delivery" in various States.
2. The Norwegian People's Aid (NPA) (herein after referred to as "Consultant" is contracted to offer services as the lead agency to deliver "Basic packages for health Services" over a period of one year in Eastern Equatoria State.
3. With the Technical Assistance of the Consultant the Grant recipient intends to apply the portion of the funds to procure the Goods and Services mentioned in 4 below.
4. The consultant now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the supply of the following lists of goods and Services. These are divided in three LOTS as follow.

LOT 1. Supply of IT Equipments and its installation (Server).

LOT 2. Renovation of two roomed CHD office in Imehejek, Lopa/Lafon County.

LOT 3. Renovation of two roomed CHD office in Chukudum, Budi County.

5. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the

World Bank's Guidelines (Procurement under IBRD loans and IDA credits) and are open to all bidders from eligible sources /Countries as defined in the guideline 5.

6. A complete set of bidding Documents in English may be obtained free of charge by interested bidders on the submission of written application to the address below and the bidding documents can be handpicked from the physical address below. A prospective bidder can apply for more than one LOT but the bid for each lot MUST be submitted separately and in a separate sealed envelopes and well labeled with the lot number and procurement Subject.

7. Bids must be delivered to the address below at or before 12:00AM East African Standard Time on September 2nd 2011. Electronic Bidding may be allowed for bidders outside Sudan. Late bids and bids that are not submitted on the bidding form will not be accepted. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address location on the date to be communicated in a later date. All bids must be accompanied by the copy of certificate of incorporation, tax compliance certificates and other relevant documents.
