## Invitation for Expressions of Interest

Contract No. MOH/RRHP/SVS/11- 3 Consultancy Services for Monitoring and Evaluation Support to the Ministry of Health of the Republic of South Sudan

The Republic of South Sudan has applied for Grant from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the Rapid Results Health Program and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this Grant to payments under the Contract for Consultancy Services for Monitoring and Evaluation Support to the Ministry of Health Southern Sudan.

Broadly, the services include: (i) Collecting information on health sector performance throughout South Sudan; (ii) Strengthening the capacity of the Ministry of Health to analyze and use data for decision-making; (iii) Building local capacity to collect and analyze data; (iv) Providing an independent assessment of the performance of agencies contracted to deliver high impact primary health care services; (v) advising on the impact of performance-based financing; and (vi) Strengthening the capacity of the Ministry of Health to manage, analyze, and use Health Management Information System (HMIS) data.

The assignment is expected to be undertaken for two years with possibility of extension depending on availability of funds and performance of the Consultant to be selected.

The Ministry of Health of the Republic of South Sudan, now invites eligible consultancy firms to indicate their Interest in providing these services. Interested firms must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services. They are thus required to submit the following: 1) description of similar assignments they have successfully accomplished; 2) description of any assignments they have successfully accomplished in similar conditions; 3) Qualifications of key staff; 4) brochures and any information to demonstrate capacity to undertake the assignment. Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers of May 2004, Revised October 1, 2006 & May 1, 2010.
