## UNANIMOUS CONSENT AGREEMENT

Timothy G. Geithner (Cal. No. 3)

*Ordered*, That on Monday, January 26, 2009 at 4 p.m., the Senate proceed to executive session to consider the nomination of Timothy F. Geithner, of New York, to be Secretary of the Treasury; that there be 2 hours of debate, with the time equally divided and controlled between the Chair and Ranking Member of the Committee on Finance or their designees; that at 6 p.m., without further intervening action or debate, the Senate proceed to vote on confirmation of the nomination; that upon confirmation, the motion to reconsider be laid upon the table; that no other motions be in order; and that the President be immediately notified of the Senate's action and the Senate then resume legislative session.
