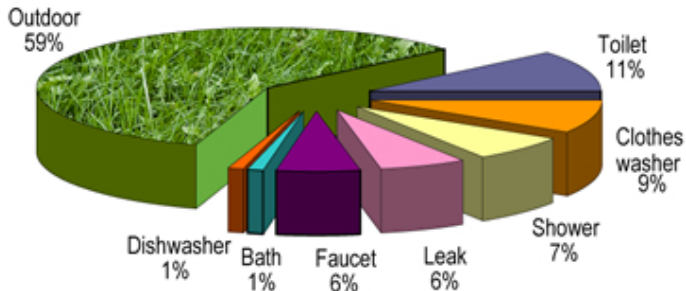


Where can you save the most **water** and **money** in your home?
