Have ALL (3) the following screening tests been done? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cardiac Screening (O2 sat)</li> <li>• Hearing (ALGO)</li> <li>• Newborn Screen</li> </ul>			
If indicated, baby has blood glucose ≥ 45 x3?
