NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PROPOSED RATE INCREASES FOR WASTEWATER SERVICE FISCAL YEAR 2015/16

On **Tuesday**, **June 9**, **2015**, the Sunnyvale City Council will hold a public hearing regarding proposed increases to utility rates for wastewater (sewer) services provided by the City of Sunnyvale. The hearing is scheduled to be held at **7 p.m.** in the City Council Chambers located at **456 W. Olive Avenue in Sunnyvale**.

The City of Sunnyvale owns and operates a wastewater collection and treatment system within the City of Sunnyvale, northern Cupertino, and part of the City of San Jose. As part of the yearly process of reviewing the financial condition of Sunnyvale's utilities, the City Council considers annual adjustments to the City's wastewater rates. If you are receiving this notice, it is because you receive a yearly assessment from the City of Sunnyvale on your property tax bill for wastewater service at the above property address.

The proposed increase for wastewater service is 8% for the coming fiscal year. Wastewater rates are based entirely on Sunnyvale's costs of operating and maintaining its wastewater facilities and services. No tax revenues are used to cover the cost of wastewater services. The proposed increase reflects needed improvements to the City's wastewater collection and treatment infrastructure, and increases in operating and regulatory compliance costs. Specifically, the City has begun a significant effort to rehabilitate its aging sewage treatment plant. This project, which is anticipated to be in excess of \$300 million, will be phased in over ten to fifteen years. Details regarding factors driving rate changes will be available in the 2015/16 Utility Rate Report to Council, available in the City Clerk's Office and on the City's website (www.sunnyvale.ca.gov) at least two weeks prior to the hearing.

PROTEST PROCESS

If you wish to protest the proposed service rate increases, the City must receive your *written and signed* protest prior to the close of the public hearing on June 9, 2015. As required by California Proposition 218, should the City Council receive written protests from a majority of customers, the proposed rates will not become effective and the current rates will remain in place. For your protest to be counted, please include the address(es) or Assessor's Parcel number(s) of the property(ies) you own. Email protests will not be counted. Protests are limited to one per parcel. The rates charged to customers outside of Sunnyvale city limits are the same as charged inside the City with the exception of an administrative fee¹ added to cover the cost of placing the charges on the property tax roll.

Rates will become effective upon adoption by the Sunnyvale City Council and will appear on your Santa Clara County property tax bill.
