All, As you may already be aware, on December 15, 2008, the Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit partially upheld a Amendment challenge to the constitutionality of the nondisclosure provisions of the NSL statutes. The court held the subsections 2709(c) and 3511(b) are unconstitutional to the extent that they impose a nondisclosure requirement with placing on the government the burden of initiating judicial review of that requirement.
