Due to the success of last year's event, many participating designers and artists are returning this year and include well-known California jewelers April Higashi and Eric Silva as well as textile artists Anya, Bethany Brandon, Jean Cacicedo, Judith Content, Marla Duran, Ana Lisa Hedstrom, Carole Lee Shanks and Mark Thomas.

New designers joining Style 2007 include Bay Area-based clothing designers, Giselle Shepatin, who will feature her colorful woven sculptural clothing, and Cari Borja, known for her glamorous ruffled flowing designs. New jewelry designers include Maja, who will showcase silver and gold jewelry featuring her distinctive perforation technique, Mark Kanazawa, who will feature his unique "wood grain" jewelry and modern pearls, and well-known beadwork jeweler, lecturer and author, Valerie Hector.
