Cubberley Artists showcase dynamic new work at free community events this month

PALO ALTO, CA – The Cubberley Artist Studio Program (CASP), a thriving community of 25 artists based at Palo Alto’s Cubberley Community Center, is hosting two exciting free events for the public. *Meet the Artists* will be held on November 12th from 6-9pm and the 15th Annual *Holiday Open House* will be from 11am to 5pm November 21st.

Cubberley artists will showcase their new work as visitors of all ages enjoy the opportunity to experience the creative environment of artists’ working studios, engage in art making, and view work made in a variety of media and approaches, ranging from traditional fine arts to innovative mixed media, performance and social practice.

On Thursday, November 12, 6-8 pm, CASP will hold its first annual *Meet the Artists* night, with a fast-paced Pecha Kucha style group presentation at Cubberley Lecture Room H-1, where artists will each have 2 minutes to show 6 photographs of their work. Immediately following and just a few steps away in the ArtLab, CASP will host a reception with light refreshments and a pop-up exhibition. Artists will mingle with the public to answer questions and discuss their artwork, ideas and process. Many artworks on display will be available for sale.

On Saturday, November 21, 11 am – 5 pm, CASP artists will hold their 15th annual *Holiday Open House* to celebrate the holiday season with the Palo Alto community. For this day only, CASP artists Ken Edwards and Marianne Lettieri will present, along with MakeX student mentor Takaaki Sagawa, a curated exhibition of projects produced in the MakeX lab, adjacent to CASP studios, during the past year. MakeX students will be on hand to give tours of their unique workspace and host hands-on activities for visitors. Additionally, CASP artists Servane Briand and Paloma Lucas are leading a mini-book activity for visitors in their studio, E3. CASP artist Barbara Gunther will host a printmaking workshop from 1-4pm in her studio, U2.

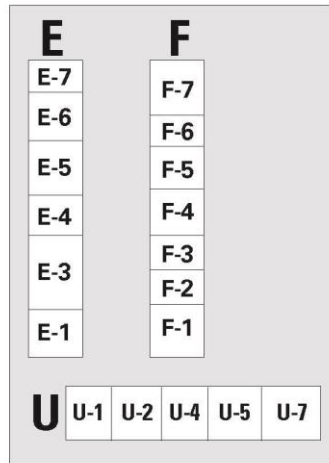

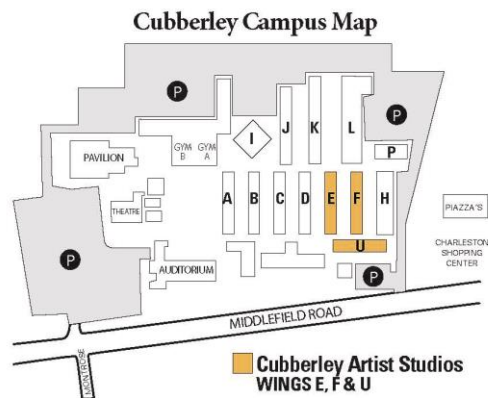
