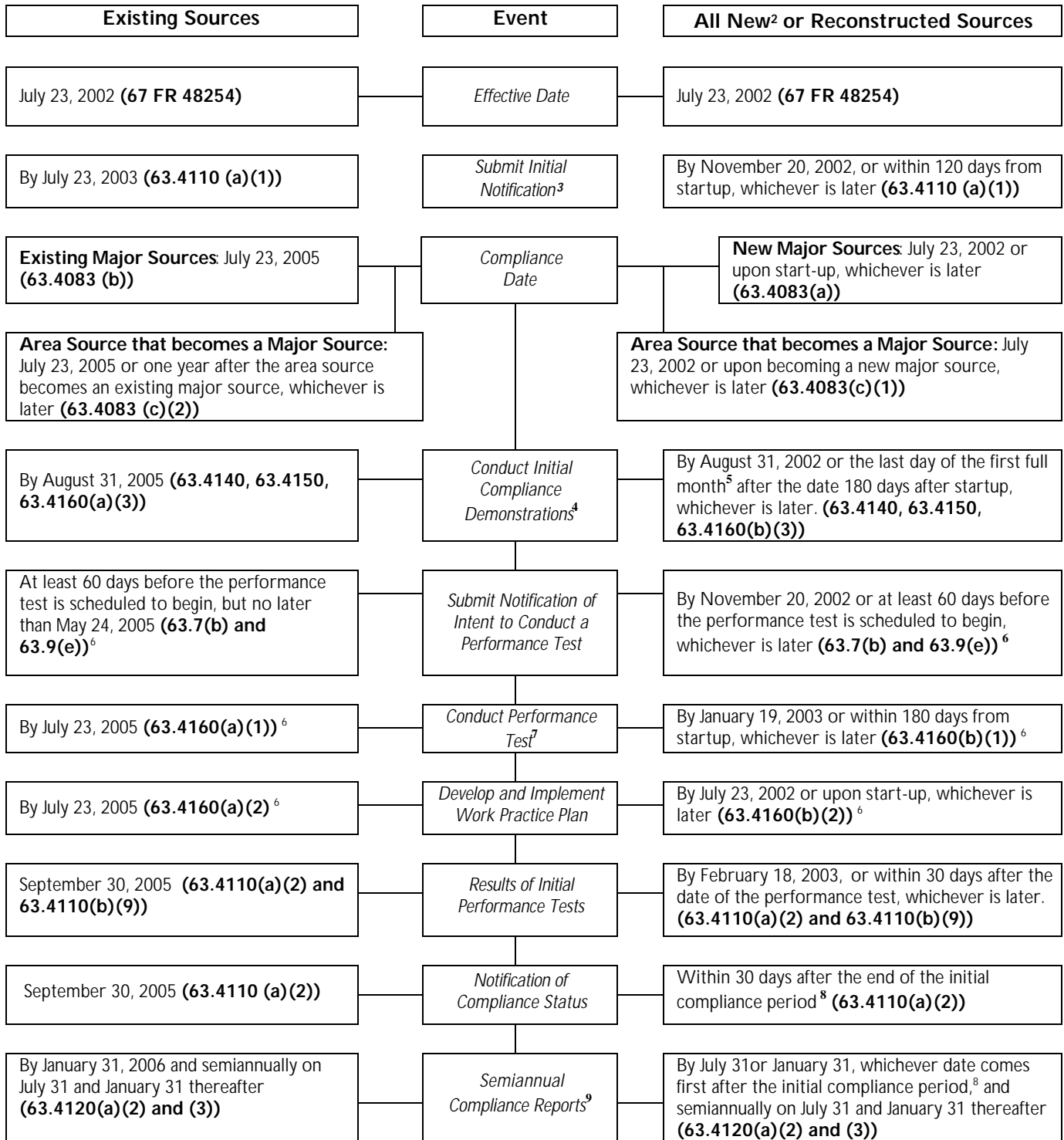


**COMPLIANCE TIMELINE<sup>1</sup>**  
**SURFACE COATING OF LARGE APPLIANCES**  
(67 FR 48254)



1. This timeline does not take into account special situations such as compliance extensions.  
2. New affected source: An affected source that the construction or reconstruction of which is begun after the effective date of this rule. **(63.4082(c))**  
3. A title V permit application may be used in lieu of the initial notification, provided that the information specified in 63.9(b) is included, the State has an approved part 70 operating permit program and the State has received delegation of authority from EPA.  
4. Applies to all three compliance options: compliant coatings option, emission rate without add-on controls option and emission rate with add-on controls option.  
5. A month is defined as a calendar month or a pre-specified period of 28 to 35 days to allow for flexibility in recordkeeping when data are based on a business accounting period.  
6. Applies emission rate with add-on controls option only.  
7. Performance tests must be performed for each capture system and add-on control device, except for solvent recovery systems. For solvent recovery systems, the first

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material balance must be initiated.

8. The initial compliance period for new sources begins upon startup or July 23, 2002, whichever is later, and ends on the last day of the first full month after the compliance date, or the date you conduct the performance test of the emission capture systems and add-on control devices or initiate the first liquid-liquid material balance for a solvent recovery system, whichever is later. If the compliance date occurs on any day other than the first day of a month, then the initial compliance period extends through the end of that month plus the next month. **(63.4140, 63.4150, or 63.4160(b)(3))**

9. The initial semiannual report must cover the period beginning on the day after the end of the initial compliance period and ends on June 30 or December 31, whichever date is the first date following the end of the initial compliance period. **(63.4120(a)(1))**
