**SUBJECT:** Counties Classified as Urban-1/Urban-2 Based on the 2000 Census

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On February 6, 1998 (63 FR 6288), the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) proposed standards for major and area sources in the Oil and Natural Gas Production Source Category. When the major source rule was finalized on June 17, 1999 (64 FR 32610) under 40 CFR part 63, subpart HH, the regulation of oil and natural production area source facilities was deferred. EPA is now proposing amendments to subpart HH to add regulatory language for area sources.

In the February 1998 action EPA proposed a location criterion for determining applicability to the area source standard. Each TEG dehydration unit with a throughput greater than 3 MMscf/d and benzene emissions greater than 1 tpy would be subject to the area source standard if they were located in counties classified as urban. EPA used statistical data from the U.S. Department of Commerce's Bureau of Census to classify every county in the U.S. into one of three classifications [63 FR 6293]:

1. Urban-1: counties which include a metropolitan statistical area (MSA)<sup>1</sup> with a population greater than 250,000. If any part of the county contains an Urban-1 area, then the entire county is considered Urban-1.
2. Urban-2: counties designated as urban by the Bureau of Census (areas which comprise one or more central places and the adjacent densely settled surrounding fringe that together have a minimum of 50,000 persons). The urban fringe consists of contiguous territory having a density of at least 1,000 persons per square mile. If greater than 50 percent of the population is classified as urban, then the entire county is classified as Urban-2.

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<sup>1</sup> An MSA is defined as follows: A geographic entity defined by the federal Office of Management and Budget for use by federal statistical agencies, based on the concept of a core area with a large population nucleus, plus adjacent communities having a high degree of economic and social integration with that core. Qualification of an MSA requires the presence of a city with 50,000 or more inhabitants, or the presence of an Urbanized Area (UA) and a total population of at least 100,000 (75,000 in New England). The county or counties containing the largest city and surrounding densely settled territory are central counties of the MSA. Additional outlying counties qualify to be included in the MSA by meeting certain other criteria of metropolitan character, such as a specified minimum population density or percentage of the population that is urban. MSAs in New England are defined in terms of minor civil divisions, following rules concerning commuting and population density.

3. Rural: counties not designated as urban by the Bureau of Census. If less than 50 percent of the population is not classified as urban, then the county is classified as rural.

For the proposed amendments, EPA is also considering a location criterion for determining applicability to the area source standards. Each TEG dehydration unit that meets the throughput and emissions cutoffs and is not located in a county designated as Urban-1 or Urban-2 would not be subject to the area source standards. Therefore, using the classifications defined in the February 1998 action and 2000 statistical data from the Bureau of Census,<sup>2</sup> EPA has classified every county in the U.S. as Urban-1, Urban-2, and Rural counties. Table 1 presents a list of all the counties in the U.S. that are classified as Urban-1 and Urban-2. All counties not listed in Table 1 are Rural counties.

Tables 2 through 5 present changes in classification from the February 1998 proposed rule. Table 2 presents the counties that have not changed classification. Table 3 presents the counties that were classified as rural in the February 1998 proposed rule but now are classified as Urban-1 or Urban-2. Each TEG dehydration unit located in a county listed in Table 3 was not subject to the February 1998 proposed area source standard but would be subject to the current proposed amendments.

Table 4 presents counties that were classified as Urban-1 or Urban-2 (respectively) in the February 1998 proposal but are classified as rural counties based on 2000 statistical data from the Bureau of Census. TEG dehydration units located in one of the counties listed in Tables 4 would not be subject to the proposed amendments. Finally, Table 5 presents the counties that changed from Urban-2 to Urban-1 or from Urban-1 to Urban-2.

When classifying counties based on 2000 statistical data, EPA noted the following:

- In the 1990 census, there was a county listed in Florida called Dade county. In the 2000 census, this county is called Miami-Dade.
- In the 1990 census, there was a county listed in Virginia called South Boston City. The 2000 census does not have South Boston City listed as a county.
