Notice of Proposed Issuance of Administrative Order on Consent

The respondent is in violation of the SDWA and 40 C.F.R. § 144.51(a), for failing to comply with permit conditions for the underground injection wells shown below. The respondent has waived the right to contest allegations set forth in the AOC.

The proposed AOC is open to comment from the public. Persons wishing to comment upon any aspect of the proposed AOC are invited to submit written comments within 30 days of this notice. The Public Notice Number should be included in the first page of comments. The commenter must provide his or her name and complete mailing address. All comments received during the public notice period will be made part of the administrative record of the AOC and will be available for public review. After consideration of all timely written comments, the requirements and policies in the SDWA and appropriate regulations, the EPA will make a final determination regarding the issuance of an AOC.

Any person who comments will receive a copy of the proposed AOC. Within 30 days of receipt of the AOC, a commenter may petition the Regional Administrator to set aside the proposed AOC on the basis that material evidence was not considered. Copies of the petition shall be served to the parties. Unless a petition is filed, an AOC becomes effective 10 days after the close of the comment period.
