NIH CLOSEOUT - Final Invention Statement (FIS) Submitting Your Final Invention Statement (FIS) in Commons

A Final Invention Statement is required for all awards except Training grants, Fellowships, and certain other programs—e.g., activity codes C06, R13, R25, S10. It should include all inventions which were conceived or first actually reduced to practice during the course of work under the grant or award, from the original effective date of support through the date of completion or termination.

Initiating your Final Invention Statement in Commons

- Log into Commons (https://commons.era.nih.gov/) using your ERA Commons ID
- Click on "List of Applications/Grants", select the applicable grant and click the "Requires Closeout" link
- From the Closeout Screen click "Process Final Invention Statement"

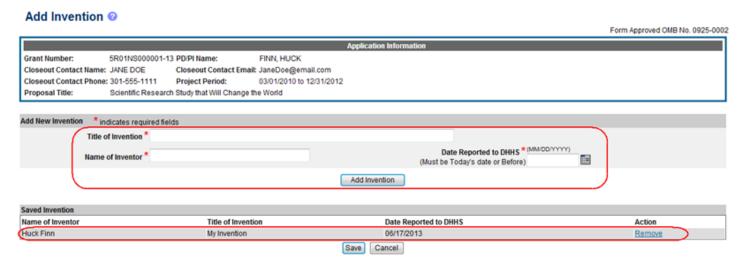
