PROGRAM: At the Harvard Medical School - Boston: Applications being accepted now for a one-year, degree-granting, full-time fellowship from July 2010 – June 2011. Program prepares California's physicians, dentists, and mental health professionals for leadership positions in health policy in a multicultural and ethnically diverse society. Incorporates intensive training in health policy, leadership, and multiculturalism. Leads to MPH degree at Harvard School of Public Health or MPA degree at Harvard's Kennedy School of Government. Full program includes courses, seminars, leadership forums, practicum, site visits, shadowing, and mentoring by senior faculty and public health leaders.

QUALIFICATIONS: Physicians, dentists, and doctoral level mental health professionals, who currently reside in or are legal residents of California; board eligible or certified physicians, dentists with a DDS or DMD from an accredited dental school, and accredited mental health professionals at the doctoral level; awareness of, or interest and experience in dealing with, the health needs of underserved populations in California; intention to pursue a career in public health, health policy, or academia; U.S. citizenship or permanent residency.

FUNDING: \$50,000 stipend; tuition and fees; health insurance; other program expenses
