Note: During this period the number of students enrolling in Stanford's Coterminal Bachelor's and Master's Degree program has increased from 18% to 24% of the graduating class. The Coterminal Program permits Stanford undergraduates to study for a bachelor's and a master's degree simultaneously. Students in this program may take additional time to complete the bachelor's degree, yet overall they graduate at a rate higher than the average for the class as a whole.
