Upcoming Material Ordering and Pre-ID Deadlines

Deadlines for test material orders and Pre-ID are listed below for the final administration of the California High School Exit Examination (CAHSEE) for the 2008-09 school year. All deadlines are at 5 p.m. CAHSEE administration questions should be directed to the Educational Testing Service (ETS) CAHSEE Support Center at 1-800-241-5687.

As a reminder, all grade ten students should have taken the CAHSEE in either the February or March census administration. Grade ten students who were absent for their district's census administration may be offered a makeup opportunity in May. Results from the March administration are scheduled to be available for district coordinators to download on approximately May 13.

Test Administration Training Workshops and Webcasts

CAHSEE Independent Evaluation Study Request for Proposal (RFP)

As a result of the Kidd (Chapman) settlement agreement, the CDE is required to contract with an external consultant to conduct a study on grade twelve students who (1) have taken the CAHSEE with modifications and/or accommodations specified in their respective individualized education program (IEP) or Section 504 plans; (2) have not passed the CAHSEE; and (3) who have satisfied or will satisfy all other requirements for graduation from high school. As a result of the RFP process, the CDE issued a contract on January 27, 2009, to American Institutes for Research (AIR).

Researchers from the AIR and representatives from the CDE will present an overview of the design and methodology of this study during two public meetings to be held on April 9, 2009, at Orange COE, and on April 30, 2009, at Sacramento COE. The purpose of these public meetings is to seek comments on the study from parents, students, teachers, and other interested parties.
