The EPA welcomes the opportunity to share information about its use of piloted airplanes in Nebraska and Iowa, as well as nationally. EPA uses these flights as a cost-effective tool to help the Agency and our state partners minimize costs and reduce the number of on-site inspections across the country. With one combined animal feeding operation inspection costing upwards of \$10,000 and Region 7 responsible for improving water quality in about 1,800 miles of impaired Nebraska waters, across 50,000 square miles, EPA uses tools, like airplane flights, to focus our resources and compliance efforts where they are needed most.

This Agency stands ready to work with you to arrange a mutually beneficial format and time for this important conversation.
