To be exempted from the 106A/B requirement, the graduate student must provide a transcript showing the completed sequence of computer science programming courses, or demonstrate that he or she has completed more advanced courses in Stanford's computer science department that require skills beyond 106A and 106B, e.g., data mining or machine learning classes.
