

eProtocol Release Update

Our eProtocol release on October 6, 2012, includes the following changes in IRB and APLAC:

IRB

- Accessing your current approved consent forms has just gotten easier. A new column, “Consent Forms”, has been added to the “Active Protocols” section of the Dashboard. Using your mouse, hover over the words “Download Consents”. A pop-up will appear that lists consent forms on the protocol. Click on the consent form that you would like to download and your computer will open the consent form for you. **Remember to always go to eProtocol to get your current approved consent form when consenting participants.**
- The Attachments section has a new option in the dropdown to add DSMB (Data Safety Monitoring Board) Reports.

APLAC

- Questions have been added regarding Use of Nano Particles and Human Fetal Tissue in the "Are You Using" section; “Room Number” has been added to the “Species” information and “Biohazard Agents” has 2 new options in the dropdown list.
