## **eProtocol Release Update**

Our eProtocol release on October 6, 2012, includes the following changes in IRB and APLAC:

#### IRB

- Accessing your current approved consent forms has just gotten easier. A new column, "Consent Forms", has been added to the "Active Protocols" section of the Dashboard. Using your mouse, hover over the words "Download Consents". A pop-up will appear that lists consent forms on the protocol. Click on the consent form that you would like to download and your computer will open the consent form for you. Remember to always go to eProtocol to get your current approved consent form when consenting participants.
- The Attachments section has a new option in the drop down to add DSMB (Data Safety Monitoring Board) Reports.

### **APLAC**

 Questions have been added regarding Use of Nano Particles and Human Fetal Tissue in the "Are You Using" section; "Room Number" has been added to the "Species" information and "Biohazard Agents" has 2 new options in the dropdown list.
