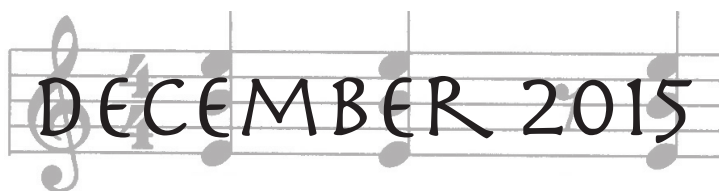


# BING MUSIC SERIES
