Starting next week, public gas and electric utilities are celebrating the benefits of community ownership. But the City of Palo Alto Utilities, which not only operates a gas and electric utility but also provides water, sewer and fiber optic services, is taking their outreach campaign to another level.

We are celebrating <u>all</u> our utilities for the entire month of October. **And we're belting out our message about how public utilities rock in a <u>fun musical video</u>.** The video, taped by a student intern and featuring Utilities employees, shows that while we are not professional singers, we take great pride in what we do!

Public Power Week and Public Natural Gas Week both run October 6 – 12.

The goal of these national "week-long campaigns" is to bring public attention to the benefits of communityowned utilities, including having local control, fairer rates and generating support for other city services like libraries and public safety. Specifically for the City of Palo Alto, local control has resulted in decisions to have a 100% carbon-neutral electric supply, an upgraded emergency water supply system, aggressive water, gas and sewer main replacement programs, high-impact efficiency programs and personalized customer service.


