The governance issues were then discussed and by consensus, it was agreed that in case of difference of opinion, the majority will rule.

It was agreed that the evaluation of suicide prevention efforts and the monitoring of workgroups should be a function of the SPOC and not the data workgroup, as envisaged in the plan. Recommended changes in duty assignments from the Data Workgroup to either SPOC, Suicide Prevention Coordinator's office, or other workgroup were also agreed to by the SPOC.
