Los Gatos Community Meeting Summary Report

The Santa Clara County Roads and Airports Department and Santa Clara County Planning Department held a community meeting to discuss the County General Plan Circulation and Mobility Element’s proposal for the county unincorporated road system. The PowerPoint presentation covered the proposed road system as well as policy direction regarding private roads. The meeting was held on September 8, 2014, from 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. at the City of Los Gatos Council Chambers located at 110 East Main Street. Dan Collen, Deputy Director, Santa Clara County Roads & Airports Department; Dawn Cameron, County Transportation Planner, Santa Clara County Roads & Airports Department; Ivana Yeung, Planner, Santa Clara County Roads & Airports Department; and Michelle Hunt, Project Manager, Hexagon Transportation Consultants staffed the event. Two community members attended the meeting. After the twenty-minute orientation presentation, the floor was open for an informal Q&A discussion. The following is a list of the questions and the staff responses. Comment cards were available for the community to submit comments.



Comment/Question	Response
How do the roads changes affect Stanford University?	Policies for trails and proposed cross section standards may have a future effect on trail connections.
Will the Expressway Study draft be ready in October, since it feeds into the Circulation and Mobility Element?	The Department is analyzing feasibility and will hold another round of round of community meetings in October. The draft environmental impact report is in the works for the Circulation and Mobility Element. Policies from the Expressway Study will be included in the Circulation and Mobility Element.
Do you foresee any changes to LOS standards?	The County will work with cities to set individual standards (for unincorporated pockets adjacent to city limits). The expressways operate on County standards and serve residential and business land uses.
