Definitions:

Fuel Blending: Waste treatment process where waste is burned as a fuel to generate energy.

Incinerator: Destroys waste at a high temperature. **Landfill**: Burying waste to contain and stablilize.

Neutralization: Adjusts Ph (Ph 7) to make acids and bases neutral. **Recycle**: Recovering used materials for use in a manufacturing process.
