- Scholarship awards are based on merit (primary) and need (secondary), and are made only after admission decisions are finalized. IUC is obligated to consider the donor’s criteria when making awards.
- IUC scholarship funds are limited. Students are urged to explore all avenues of funding such as FLAS and NSEP as well as private foundations such as the Blakemore Foundation. Most IUC scholarship awards take the form of partial to full tuition grants.
