Researchers at Stanford University are developing a Research Registry to better understand the causes and treatment of **Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)** and **Intellectual Disability (ID)**.

The **Research Registry** will allow researchers:

- * to identify and recruit patients who might be eligible for participation in future research studies.
- * to review and study the medical records of your child to help answer questions about ASD and/or ID and its treatment.

In order to be part of the Research Registry your child must have a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder and/or Intellectual Disability.
