

# Participants needed for Autism Twin Research

Stanford University researchers are currently recruiting same-sex twin pairs with autism *and* twin pairs without autism (i.e. typically developing) to participate in a research study. The study compares twins with Autism Spectrum Disorder to typically developing twins so we can better understand the causes of autism.

## To be eligible for this study your twins must:

- ▶ Be a same-sex twin pair between the ages of 3 and 14 years old
- ▶ One or both of the twins have been diagnosed with an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

## OR

- ▶ Both twins are in good medical health and do not have a severe neuropsychiatric disorder.
- ▶ **And** be willing and able to complete an MRI scan and behavioral testing at Stanford University
