EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONS

Accident

Report the emergency. Give first aid. Stay with the victim.

Fire

Report the fire. Pull fire alarm. Evacuate. Do not use elevators.

Earthquake

Duck, cover, and hold on. Wait until shaking stops to evacuate. Do not use elevators. Buildings will be examined before re-entry.

Bomb Threat

Report a threat or suspicious object. Follow police instructions.

Power Outage

Most outages are resolved quickly. Wait for situation updates.
