Report the emergency. Give first aid. Stay with the victim. Report the fire. Pull fire alarm. Evacuate. Do not use elevators. Duck, cover, and hold on. Wait until shaking stops to evacuate. Do not use elevators. Buildings will be examined before re-entry. Report a threat or suspicious object. Follow police instructions.

Most outages are resolved quickly. Wait for situation updates.
