**SUBJECT: Dayton SITREP #6; November 10, 1995, 1:30am.**

Intense shuttling between Serbs and Bosnians residences dominated Thursday in Dayton. Full court press underway on constitution, elections, and map. Both Milosevic and Izetbegovic fully engaged. Some progress, but no agreed decisions. Shuttle efforts continue overnight and into Friday.

Storm clouds thicken over IFOR annex. Richard Perle began efforts on behalf of Bosnians. Main thrust to raise level of IFOR obligations on international border and election security. Also interested in removing arms control provisions from annex. Wes Clark leading extensive review of IFOR annex with Perle and Bosnian team. Heads up: Principals may have to deal with scenario where Bosnians agree to constitution, elections, and map, but cost will be increased obligations by IFOR. Potential benefit of Perle involvement is his willingness to influence key members on Hill in favor of U.S. participation. He supports IFOR strongly, feeling only that it could have stronger mandate. Stay tuned.

Wednesday's map marathon gave way to multiple proximity meetings. Bosnian Serbs provided changes to Bosnian Government 60% map. Expect these efforts to continue for several days, with each side likely to withhold key concessions until other issues unfold.

Eastern Slavonia talks continue but it is impossible to tell whether today's events foreshadow breakthrough when Christopher arrives or are simply SLOBO-DRAMA..

In fascinating exchange with Milosevic over lunch, he told me: "General Kerrick, while America's professional prestige is on the line, my head and life are at stake - literally." He wants us to believe that Krajisnik and others are capable and willing to remove him if he goes to far. Rabin remains fresh memory.

Richard (a.k.a. Dick) still hopes you will visit.
