"We felt -- the bench felt -- that it was off them. I didn't see the replay. It was difficult to really see that. They had plenty of opportunity to look at it, so we have to live with it."

On Battling Back

"We made some plays. Willie Atwood was pretty good on offense in the second half, and he gave us a good job of giving us a chance to win, but overall, you just have a bad taste in your mouth for how we played through large stretches early in the game and again had to climb uphill."
