Dorian Pickens and Marcus Allen

On Dorian's big night:

DP: "I felt like I had it going. I wanted to go out in the first half aggressively off the bench, especially when Rosco went down with those two quick fouls. We knew as a team we had to pick up the slack a little bit, offensively for sure. Really our defense in the first half and throughout the game led us to easy buckets on offense and it carried over."

MA: "I see it all the time, but he finally put it together in a game. Malcolm and I call Dorian "The Laser" because his shot is always on point. I'm glad to see him knock all his shots down especially in the first half. Very exciting."

Dorian on him coming off of the bench:

DP: "There's not really a difference for me other than I'm not in the game when the ball is tipped off. But when I do come in the game I have the same mindset; be aggressive, shoot my shots and set up my teammates and give them their open looks as well. For me there's really no difference, coming off the bench I have to bring that little scoring burst, that energy on defense and help the team in any way I can."

On USC starting a run:
