The Stanford women's gymnastics team received a No. 2 seed to the NCAA regionals and is headed to Champaign, Ill., to compete in the six-team event Saturday at 2 p.m. PT for the right to qualify for the NCAA Championships. This marks the 29th consecutive season that Stanford has qualified for NCAA regional competition. In the Champaign Regional - one of six around the country - Oklahoma is the No. 1 seed. Others, in order of seeds, are Denver, Illinois, Kentucky, and Illinois-Chicago. The top two advance to the 12-team NCAA Championships in Duluth, Ga., April 20-22.

Stanford at the Pac-12 Championships

Stanford finished fourth at the Pac-12 Championships March 24 in Salt Lake City, despite scoring a season-high 196.825 points. The Cardinal had two individual champions and had 11 scores of 9.90 or above, including five on the balance beam and three on vault. Its' team scores of 49.500 on beam, 49.450 on vault and 49.425 on floor were season bests. The Cardinal led through three rotations, but struggled on the final rotation, the uneven bars, to fall to fourth. UCLA captured the title.

Stanford's Individual Pac-12 Champions

Stanford's two individual champions were:

• **Ivana Hong, fr.:** Hong led a Stanford charge with another 9.950. Hong, the 2009 U.S. senior national champion on vault and beam, scored a collegiate career high to tie for first on vault with UCLA's Olivia Courtney and Vanessa Zamarripa.

• **Ashley Morgan, jr.:** Morgan took sole possession of the floor title by matching her season and collegiate career best of 9.950, with senior teammate Nicole Pechanec second at 9.925. Morgan won her second consecutive floor title and Stanford's fourth consecutive, extending a streak that began with Carly Janiga in 2009 and 2010.

All-Conference Gymnasts

Stanford had three All-Pac-12 selections in 2012:

• **Ashley Morgan, jr.:** First team, floor exercise; first team, uneven bars; Also, 2011 first team, floor; 2010 second team, floor.

• **Ivana Hong, fr.:** Second team, vault.

• **Shona Morgan, so.:** Second team, balance beam.

Previous all-conference selections:

• **Alyssa Brown, sr.:** 2011 first-team, beam; 2010 second team, beam.

• **Nicole Pechanec, sr.:** 2011 and 2010 second team, floor.

The Fab Five

The Stanford freshman class figures to be one of the best in school history. The class is comprised of two-time U.S. senior national champion and 2012 Pac-12 vault champion Ivana Hong, U.S. national team member Samantha Shapiro, 2008 British Olympian Rebecca Wing, and two-time Junior Olympic national qualifiers Alex Archer and Pauline Hanset. Hong and Shapiro were limited by injuries, but are now in the lineup in multiple events. All have made an impact in the lineup. Shapiro has scored 9.875s on bars and vault, Hong has scored 9.9's on vault and beam, Wing has performed at leadoff in three events, Hanset has scored four 9.85's on floor, and Archer has been in the vault lineup in four meets.

Spinner's Comeback

One of the more remarkable stories involving this year's Stanford team is the comeback of sophomore Amanda Spinner. After missing two years of competition because of injuries, Spinner returned to action Feb. 12 at California and scored a 9.750 on the balance beam. Since then, she has become the team's most consistent performer on that event, with a team-leading 9.846 scoring average. Spinner has scored a collegiate career best of 9.90 in each of the past two meets, including the Pac-12 Championships where she tied for fifth.

NCAA Regional Experience

This is Stanford's 29th consecutive NCAA regional appearance. The following are current Stanford gymnasts (six) who competed as part of past regional lineups:

Three regionals: Nicole Pechanec (2009, 2010, 2011).

Two: Alyssa Brown (2010, 2011), Ashley Morgan (2010, 2011).

Stanford's NCAA Regional History

- Stanford has qualified 29 consecutive seasons.
- Stanford has finished in the top two to advance to NCAA's in four of the past five seasons.
- Stanford teams under Kristen Smyth (since 2002) have won four regional titles, were runners-up three times, and have a third- and two fourth-place finishes.
- Twenty Stanford gymnasts have combined for 36 individual titles, including 31 since 1998.
- Stanford is seeking its sixth NCAA regional title, all since 1999.

Super Six Experience

Stanford has four gymnasts who were part of the lineups that competed in the 2010 NCAA Super Six finals in Gainesville, Fla., on the Cardinal's fourth-place team. They are: Alyssa Brown, Ashley Morgan, Nicole Pechanec, and Jenny Peter.

International Experience

Stanford's roster includes seven gymnasts with senior national team experience. The list includes two Olympians, two Olympic alternates, two U.S. senior national team competitors, and five World Championships veterans.

This list doesn't include Kristina Vaculik, who is taking a year off from school to prepare for the 2012 Olympics, which her Canadian team has qualified for.

• Senior **Alyssa Brown** was a 2008 Canadian Olympic team alternate, competed in two World Championships, and won a silver on vault at the 2006 Commonwealth Games. She is a two-time Canadian champion.

• Freshman **Pauline Hanset** represented Belgium, the country of her birth, in a four-nation meet in Germany in 2011.

• Freshman **Ivana Hong**, a national champion on vault and beam in 2009, was a 2008 U.S. Olympic team alternate. She was a bronze medalist on the beam at the 2009 World Championships and a team gold medalist at the 2007 worlds. Hong also earned a 2007 Pan Am Games bronze in the all-around.

• Sophomore **Shona Morgan** competed for Australia in the 2008 Olympics, finishing 15th in the all-around. She was a five-time national champion and competed in three World Championships.

• Senior **Nicole Pechanec** competed in three World Championships and two European Championships for the Czech Republic, the home country of her parents, and won a Czech national title on floor.

• Freshman **Samantha Shapiro** competed for the U.S. senior national team from 2009-11, winning several international meet titles. Earlier, she won three U.S. junior national championships.

• Freshman **Rebecca Wing** competed for Great Britain in the 2008 Olympics. She also competed in two World Championships and two European Championships.

2011 in Review

Stanford went 20-4 in the 2011 regular season, opening with a school-record 15 consecutive victories. The Cardinal went 6-2 against teams that advanced to the NCAA Super Six finals, including handing Utah its first home loss in four years and Michigan its first in three. The Cardinal also displayed a measure of perseverance, three times rallying from behind or a tie in the final rotation to win.

Meet recaps

NorCal Quad Meet

STANFORD -- A pair of 9.9 scores, by junior Ashley Morgan (floor) and senior Nicole Pechanec (bars), highlighted Stanford's season-opening victories over San Jose State, Sacramento State, and UC Davis, before a packed Burnham Pavilion.

Washington dual meet

STANFORD -- Stanford trailed 98.075-97.900 after the first two rotations, but Ashley Morgan's 9.900 and freshman Rebecca Wing's 9.875 helped propel the Cardinal to a lead it would not relinquish. In all, Stanford's top four beam scores of the early season all came on in the 195.925-195.725 victory at Burnham Pavilion.

Oregon State dual meet

CORVALLIS, Ore. -- Alyssa Brown or Nicole Dayton each earned Stanford's highest scores of the season, on the beam and vault, respectively, in the Cardinal's 196.800-194.525 loss to Oregon State. Brown scored a winning 9.925 and Dayton a second-place 9.90.

UCLA dual meet

LOS ANGELES -- Nicole Pechanec tied for first in floor exercise (9.90) and scored her career-high in the all-around (39.325) to help No. 12 Stanford to its season-high score in a 197.250-196.450 loss to No. 10 UCLA at the John Wooden Center.

Cal dual meet

BERKELEY, Calif. -- Stanford freshmen Ivana Hong and Pauline Hanset earned their first collegiate victories to lead the Cardinal past Cal for the 25th consecutive time, with a 196.175-194.725 victory at Haas Pavilion. Hong tied for first on beam (9.90) and Hanset won floor (9.85).

Metroplex Challenge

FORT WORTH, Texas -- Ashley Morgan won the uneven bars (9.875) and tied with teammate Nicole Pechanec to win the floor exercise, each with a 9.925 - a score reached only twice all season in all events for the Cardinal to that point in the season.

Utah dual meet

SALT LAKE CITY -- Stanford sophomore Amanda Spinner, out more than two years with a knee injury, earned her first collegiate victory to highlight Stanford's performance in a 196.300-196.100 loss to No. 5 Utah before 14,756 at the Huntsman Center.

Stanford Tri-Meet

STANFORD -- Nicole Pechanec's 9.925 on bars was one of five Stanford scores of 9.9 or above during a meet in which the Cardinal won every event, while beating Arizona and Cal. The Cardinal extended its' unbeaten streak against Pac-12 opponents at Burnham Pavilion to 34.

TEMPE, Ariz. -- Alyssa Brown led a Stanford trio of 9.9 scores on the balance beam to help the No. 11 Cardinal to a 196.475-194.975 regular-season finale victory over Arizona State

Pacific-12 Conference Championships

SALT LAKE CITY -- Stanford scored team season highs on beam, floor, and vault to take the lead going into the final rotation, but struggled on the uneven bars to fall to fourth. Freshman Ivana Hong won the vault with a 9.95 and Ashley Morgan scored the same, to win her second consecutive conference floor title.
