• Stanford begins its seven-game home slate Saturday with a nonconference contest against UCF.

• This will be the first ever meeting between Stanford and UCF. Stanford's last game against a first-time opponent resulted in a 2014 Foster Farms Bowl win over Maryland.

• The meeting marks the first for Stanford with a current FBS program from the Sunshine State. Stanford faced Pensacola in 1903 and 1904 when the team was stationed in the San Francisco Bay. Stanford has won three postseason games (1986 Gator Bowl, 1993 Blockbuster Bowl, 2011 Orange Bowl) played in the state of Florida.

• The home opener will be UCF's first ever contest against a team from California, and its second against a Pac-12 Conference program (2002 vs. Arizona State).

• Stanford is slated to make a return trip to UCF on Sept. 14, 2019, marking its first ever regular season game played in Florida.

• The Cardinal begins its home schedule at 0-1 following last week's 16-6 setback at Northwestern. Dating to last season, Stanford has won three of its last four outings. Even more, the Cardinal has won seven straight home openers.

• Neither Stanford nor UCF enters the game ranked. Stanford is 27-4 against unranked opponents under head coach David Shaw.

• Stanford is 10-1 following a loss under head coach David Shaw. Stanford's 2014 loss to No. 25 Utah, coupled with a loss one week prior at No. 3 Oregon marked the Cardinal's first consecutive setbacks since midway through the 2009 season.

• The Cardinal is riding a 13-game nonconference home win streak into its meeting with the Knights. Its last such defeat was a 21-14 decision to Notre Dame on Nov. 24, 2007, or 2,849 days prior to Saturday's meeting.

• During the seven-year, nine-month and 19-day streak, Stanford has scored at least 34 points in nine of those contests, averaging 43.3 points/game and winning eight matchups by three or more touchdowns.

• Stanford has held opponents to 20 points or less in 11 of the 13 games, with visitors averaging 14.3 points/game.

• In 2014, Stanford out-scored its two nonconference opponents, 80-0, at Stanford Stadium.

• Since Stanford Stadium's renovation, which was completed prior to the 2006 season, the Cardinal is 14-3 (.823) at home in nonconference games.

• Stanford and Texas are the only schools out of the 68 Power 5 and independent programs in 2015 who play 12 FBS opponents, 11 of which are Power 5 schools or Notre Dame. Five of Stanford's 12 regular-season opponents -- No. 7 Oregon, No. 8 USC, No. 11 Notre Dame, No. 13 UCLA and No. 22 Arizona -- are ranked in the AP's preseason top 25.

• No program in the nation has a higher graduation rate over the last four years than Stanford (99 pct.). Even more, no Pac-12 Conference team has had more draftees over the last four years than Stanford (19).

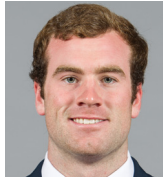
• Stanford's entire full-time coaching staff from the 2014 season returns for the 2015 campaign. It's the first time since 1999-2000 under Tyrone Willingham that Stanford's staff remained completely intact from one season to the next.

• Fifth-year senior QB Kevin Hogan, senior LG Joshua Garnett, senior LT Kyle Murphy, fifth-year senior CB Ronnie Harris, fifth-year senior OLB Kevin Anderson and senior ILB Blake Martinez serve as team captains, as voted by their teammates. Hogan is Stanford's first two-time team captain since Bo McNally (2008-09).

• Stanford has scored at least 10 points in 95 of its last 96 games (only game without at least 10 points came at Northwestern to start 2015 season).

• Stanford has rushed for at least 100 yards in 35 of its last 38 games. The only two games without at least 100 yards rushing during that stretch were 2014 losses at No. 9 Notre Dame (47) and No. 17 Arizona State (76), and a 2015 loss at Northwestern (85).

• Stanford has recorded at least one rushing touchdown 34 times in its past 36 games (only games without a rushing touchdown during that stretch were 2014 loss vs. Utah, 2015 loss at Northwestern). Stanford's last victory without accounting for a rushing touchdown was against Notre Dame on Nov. 26, 2011.

• Since 2010, Stanford has arguably been one of the nation's best offensive teams on third down. The Cardinal is fifth in converting on third downs (behind "option teams" Georgia Tech, Air Force and Navy, in addition to Alabama) during the last decade at a 47.4 clip. Defensively, Stanford has held opponents to a 34.0 pct. conversion rate, which ranks sixth nationally.

• In its season opener at Northwestern, Stanford went without an offensive touchdown for just the fifth time since 2005.

• Since former running back Toby Gerhart finished second in the 2009 Heisman Trophy race, which was one of the closest ever, only three schools have produced three different 1,500-yard rushers: Stanford (Toby Gerhart - 2009, Stepfan Taylor - 2012, Tyler Gaffney - 2013), Wisconsin and Western Kentucky. Former Western Kentucky head coach Willie Taggart was Gerhart's position coach in 2009, and current Wisconsin head coach, Paul Chryst, is the uncle of Stanford quarterback Keller Chryst.

• Stanford has held opponents to 20 or fewer points in 32 of its past 42 games. Dating to 2010, the Cardinal has held 46 of its past 61 opponents to 20 or fewer points.

• Stanford has allowed fewer than 30 points 36 times in its past 37 games. The Cardinal allowed 45 points at Oregon on Nov. 1, 2014, snapping a national-best streak of 31 consecutive games holding opponents below 30.

• Since the start of the 2012 season, Stanford has held opponents to 50 rushing yards or fewer 11 times. Only Michigan State has accomplished that feat more times (14) over the same stretch.

• Stanford has held opponents to fewer than 400 yards of total offense in 21 of its last 22 games.

• Since 2011, only Washington State (2011), UCLA (2012), Utah (2013), Cal (2014) and Oregon (2014) have exceeded their season average rushing totals against Stanford. Stanford has allowed a team to rush for 200 or more yards only three times in its last 27 outings (2013 at Army, 2014 at Oregon, 2015 at Northwestern).

• The Cardinal has at least one tackle for loss in each of its last 60 contests and at least one sack in 46 of its last 48 outings (only games without a sack came in 2013 at Army, which attempted just 10 passes, and 2015 at Northwestern).

• Stanford is one of five FBS programs to give up five or less yards per play in each of the previous three seasons (Alabama, TCU, Utah State, Wisconsin).

• Stanford has recorded at least one takeaway in 46 of its last 53 games.

• Stanford leads the FBS with 243 sacks since 2009 (Virginia Tech second with 233 heading into Sept. 7 meeting with Ohio State).

• Stanford has yielded only four field goals and one touchdown in the third quarter through its last 14 games.

• Stanford has seven interception returns for touchdowns since the last time an opponent returned one for a score (Boseko Lokombo - 2011 vs. Oregon).

• No player has caught two touchdown passes in a game against Stanford since Arizona's Austin Hill in 2012.

## Northwestern Defeats Stanford

**EVANSTON, Ill.** -- Northwestern wanted to prove a point against No. 21 Stanford, and the Wildcats drove it home with a strong running game and solid defense that produced a season-opening surprise.

Or as defensive end Dean Lowry put it: "We unleashed a caged bull today."

Freshman Clayton Thorson ran for a 42-yard touchdown while playing turnover-free ball at quarterback, Justin Jackson added 134 yards rushing, and the Wildcats beat the Cardinal 16-6.

If Northwestern felt like a caged bull, well, back-to-back 5-7 seasons will do that. The recent losing ended a five-year run of bowl appearances that included a 10-win season in 2012.

Anthony Walker broke up two passes and had a fumble recovery, and Kyle Queiro intercepted Kevin Hogan in the end zone with about a minute left to seal the win.

"It was probably one of the best performances I've seen our D play top to bottom against a ranked team maybe in my time," Pat Fitzgerald said.

Thorson scored the game's only touchdown in the second quarter. He was steady overall, completing 12 of 24 passes for 105 yards, but was fortunate not to have any interceptions considering he threw a few into double and triple coverage.

"I thought our team as a whole played well," Thorson said. "Our O-line did a great job the whole game. Me personally, I think I can always do a lot better. I missed some throws, and some decisions I made weren't great."

Thorson got high marks from Stanford linebacker Blake Martinez.

"He was commanding the offense well," Martinez said. "Keeping that pace going. They never stopped that quick offense. It was cool to see that he was able to do that his first game."

Jackson rushed 28 times. Jack Mitchell kicked three field goals, including a career-long 49-yarder that made it 16-6 with 3:38 left in the game, and the Wildcats started the season on a winning note for the first time against a ranked team since 1995.

Hogan had a rough afternoon, going 20-of-35 with 155 yards and an interception. He was sacked three times.

Christian McCaffrey ran for 66 yards, but the Cardinal managed just 240 yards on offense and scored their fewest points since 2007.

"The bottom line for us is that we have to be efficient on first down," David Shaw said. "We can't have penalties. We can't have dropped passes. We can't have missed blocks."

The Cardinal showed some of the form that carried them to four straight seasons with at least 11 wins on the game's opening possession. But Northwestern tightened its defense, forcing Stanford to settle for a 29-yard field goal by Conrad Ukropina to finish a 12-play drive.

The Wildcats tied the game on a 31-yard field goal by Mitchell with 52 seconds left in the first quarter. Thorson, who starred at suburban Wheaton North High School about 40 miles from Ryan Field, made it 10-3 midway through the second when he took advantage of a big hole on the left and scored on a 42-yard keeper.

Northwestern had a chance to add to the lead after Walker recovered a fumble by McCaffrey a few plays later. The Wildcats took over on the Stanford 38, but a 48-yard field-goal attempt by Mitchell sailed wide left with 2:35 remaining in the half.

The Wildcats picked up their first win over the Cardinal since 1958.
