### THE FARM SIX

#### RIVALRY RENEWED

Stanford and California square off in the 264th all-time meeting between the Bay Area rivals. Chapter one of the 2016 version of the rivalry is Thursday, Jan. 14, at 8 p.m. at Maples Pavilion. The two teams will meet again, Feb. 6 at Haas Pavilion in Berkeley. Both Stanford and Cal enter Thursday with a 2-2 mark in the Pac-12. The Cardinal split its two games in the state of Oregon last week, defeating Oregon State last Wednesday.

#### HOW TO FOLLOW

The game is televised on FOX Sports 1 with Gus Johnson and Bill Raftery on the call courtside from Maples Pavilion. Stanford alums John Platz and Scott Reiss have the call on KNBR 1050 AM. Drew Bontadelli and Mike Wozniak have the call on Compass Media Networks.

#### AGAINST CALIFORNIA

California holds a 144-119 advantage in the all-time series between the Bay Area rivals. Stanford earned double-digit victories over Cal in both matchups last season, posting a 72-61 win at Maples Pavilion and a 69-59 win at Haas Pavilion. The Cardinal has captured the last three games and five of the past six contests.

#### LAST MEETING WITH THE GOLDEN BEARS

Chasson Randle had a team-high 19 points to go along with double-doubles from Anthony Brown (16 pts, 11 rebs.) and Michael Humphrey (14 pts., 11 rebs.) in a 72-61 victory for the Cardinal on Feb. 21, 2015 at Maples Pavilion. Stanford shot 44 percent and out-rebounded the Golden Bears, 42-30 in the win.

#### FAMILIARITY BETWEEN STANFORD AND CAL FRESHMEN

Stanford freshman forward Marcus Sheffield and California freshman forward Jaylen Brown, both from the Atlanta, Ga. area, were teammates from seventh grade through last season on the AAU team Game Elite.

#### INSIDE THE RIVALRY

- The eight players on Stanford's current roster who have played against Cal are a combined 16-1 against the Golden Bears. Rosco Allen, Marcus Allen and Christian Sanders are a perfect 3-0, while Grant Verhoeven is the lone Cardinal who has played in a loss against the Bears.
- Stanford holds a 67-64 edge in home games in the series against California
- The Cardinal has won six of its last eight games against the Golden Bears at Maples Pavilion
- Lowest scoring game at Maples Pavilion (built in 1969), was a 43-41 2OT Cal win, on Feb. 16, 1985

## LAST TIME OUT

Three Cardinal - Michael Humphrey (18), Rosco Allen (13) and Marcus Allen (12) - scored in double figures, but Stanford fell short of a second straight road victory in Oregon with a 71-58 defeat to the Ducks on Sunday.

## STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Stanford has played the seventh-toughest schedule in the nation, according to ESPN's Daily RPI on Jan. 12. The Cardinal's first 15 opponents have totaled 152 wins (10.1 average) through Jan. 11. The six teams - SMU, Villanova, Saint Mary's, Texas, Colorado and Oregon - Stanford suffered setbacks to are a combined 77-17 through Jan. 11. Overall, Stanford's RPI is 61 through games of Jan. 11.

## AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

The Cardinal is 1-1 against top-25 teams this season and 12-21 against ranked foes in the Johnny Dawkins era. Stanford defeated No. 21 Utah (70-68) on Jan. 1 and fell to No. 8/9 Villanova (59-45) on Nov. 27.

## 150 AND COUNTING

Stanford's Anne and Tony Joseph Director of Men's Basketball, Johnny Dawkins, captured his 150th career victory in Stanford's 78-72 victory over Oregon State on Jan. 6. Dawkins, who owns a 150-106 career coaching record in his eighth season at Stanford, has taken the Cardinal to the post-season each of the last four seasons, winning at least 20 games in three of the past four years. Under Dawkins, Stanford has won two NIT titles and reached the 2014 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16.

## BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Stanford's balanced scoring attack includes five guys averaging double figures - Rosco Allen (14.1), Reid Travis (12.8), Marcus Allen (12.7), Dorian Pickens (11.4) and Michael Humphrey (10.9). The Cardinal is one of just three teams in the Pac-12 (USC and UCLA are the others) to have at least five individuals averaging double figures in the scoring column this season.

## SHEFFIELD IN PAC-12 PLAY

Freshman Marcus Sheffield is averaging 9.5 points in 21.8 minutes per game in four Pac-12 contests, after averaging 4.0 points in 11.2 minutes in the Cardinal's 11 nonconference games.

## SOPHOMORE IMPACT

The sophomore class has played a major role in the Cardinal's success this season. Despite playing without injured point guard Robert Cartwright all season and without injured forward Reid Travis' 12.8 ppg average the last seven games, Michael Humphrey (10.9 ppg) and Dorian Pickens (11.4 ppg) have each started the last seven games and have accounted for 37.5 percent of the scoring (183-of-487) during those seven contests.

## THE LINEUP

Rosco Allen was the lone Cardinal from Stanford's starting lineup in the 2015 NIT Championship game against Miami, who has started all 15 games this season. The Cardinal has used six different lineups in its first 15 games. In the last six contests, Stanford utilized the lineup of Rosco Allen, Marcus Allen, Michael Humphrey, Christian Sanders and Dorian Pickens. The Cardinal owns a 4-2 record with its current lineup.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

Stanford has won seven of its first 10 home games of the 2015-16 season and has won 10 of its last 13 at home overall. The Cardinal owns a 99-33 record at Maples Pavilion under head coach Johnny Dawkins. Stanford has won at least 10 home games for 22 straight seasons dating back to 1992-93.

**PRODUCING IN INCREASED ROLES**

The Cardinal's current lineup of Rosco Allen, Marcus Allen, Michael Humphrey, Dorian Pickens and Christian Sanders combined to average 23.7 points in 91.4 (18.3 per player) minutes per game last season. That same group is averaging a combined 54.2 points in 144.5 (28.9 per player) minutes this year.

**ROSCO ALLEN FROM DEEP**

Nearly half of Rosco Allen's field goals (30-of-66) have come from three-point range. The senior ranks 10th in the Pac-12 in three-point field goals per game (2.0). He has recorded multiple three-pointers in 10 games with at least three, five times. He has totaled 22 in the last 10 games.

**HUMPHREY'S LAST SEVEN GAMES**

Sophomore Michael Humphrey, who is averaging 10.9 points and 7.2 rebounds overall, is averaging 14.0 ppg and 8.1 rpg in his last seven contests. The forward has played the last seven games without fellow starting forward Reid Travis, who is out indefinitely with a stress reaction in his leg. The sophomore ranks eighth in the Pac-12 blocks (1.7 bpg) and 11th in rebounds (7.2 rpg). Humphrey has started 13 games, including each of the last 11 contests. The forward posted a career-high 21 points against Sacramento State. He has two double-doubles with 13 points and 11 rebounds against Green Bay and 13 points and 12 rebounds vs. Charleston Southern.

**MARCUS ALLEN EXCELLING ON BOTH ENDS OF THE COURT**

Junior Marcus Allen has scored in double figures in 10 of the 13 games he has played in this season. He ranks third on the Cardinal in scoring, averaging 12.7 ppg. The guard, who missed the first two games with a foot injury, is also averaging 2.2 assists and ranks second in the Pac-12 in steals (1.8).

**PICKENS PROVIDES SCORING PUNCH**

Sophomore Dorian Pickens is fourth on the team in scoring (11.4 ppg) and is second on the team with 24, three-pointers. Pickens had a career-best 24 points (on six, three-pointers) against Texas. He posted his first career double-double, with 11 points and a career-best 10 rebounds against No. 8 Villanova. The sophomore, who is averaging 29.0 minutes this season, averaged 2.1 points in 9.8 minutes last season.

**SANDERS, THE FLOOR GENERAL**

After totaling 81 points in 61 games over his first three seasons at Stanford, senior point guard Christian Sanders has combined to record 76 points in 15 contests this year. He scored a career-high 23 points in a career-long 31 minutes in the season-opening win over Green Bay. The senior is also averaging 2.8 assists per game with a career-best eight in the win over Charleston Southern on Nov. 15.

**TRAVIS A FORCE IN THE PAINT**

Sophomore Reid Travis is second on the team in scoring (12.8) and rebounding (7.1 rpg). His team-leading 55.7 field goal percentage ranks ninth in the conference. He scored a career-best 18 points at Saint Mary's and collected a season-high 12 rebounds against Villanova. Travis is out indefinitely with a stress reaction in his left leg.

**QUARTERBACKS TURNED POST PLAYERS**

Sophomore forwards Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey were each the quarterback of their high school football team. Travis was the signal caller for three years at DeLaSalle HS in Minnesota, before deciding to focus on basketball his senior year. Humphrey was the starting quarterback at Sunnyslope HS in Phoenix.

**FRESHMEN MAKING IMMEDIATE CONTRIBUTIONS**

The Cardinal's three-member freshman class of Josh Sharma, Marcus Sheffield and Cameron Walker have each seen action this season. Sheffield is the lone newcomer to see time in all 15 contests, earning the start in the season opener against Green Bay. Walker, who missed the first four games of the year with a calf injury, has totaled 95 minutes in 11 games. Sharma has registered 13 blocks in 77 minutes over 12 games.

**TRI-CAPTAINS**

Senior Rosco Allen, junior Marcus Allen and sophomore Reid Travis were voted captains for the 2015-16 season. Combined, the trio has played in 200 career games. All three averaged more than 20 minutes per game last season for the Cardinal.

**BROOKLYN COMEBACK**

Stanford erased a 17-point deficit (48-65) with 6:11 to play, scoring 21 of the game's final 22 points to earn a 69-66 come-from-behind victory over Arkansas in the NIT Season Tip-Off Nov. 27 at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn. Senior Rosco Allen scored eight of his career-high 25 points in the final 4:27 of the game.

**CONTROLLING THE GLASS**

Stanford's 55 rebounds against Villanova in the NIT Season Tip-Off on Nov. 26 were the most by the Cardinal in the Johnny Dawkins era. Dawkins, in his eighth season as head coach of the Cardinal, has seen Stanford record 50 or more rebounds in a game six times.

**CARTWRIGHT SIDELINED FOR SEASON**

Sophomore guard Robert Cartwright sustained a compound fracture in his right arm and will miss the 2015-16 season. The injury occurred during Stanford's team practice at Maples Pavilion on Nov. 2. Cartwright underwent successful surgery and will begin his rehabilitation period in the coming weeks. Cartwright played in all but one game, earning one start, as a freshman during Stanford's 2015 Postseason NIT Championship run. The point guard averaged 1.9 points in 11.1 minutes per game. He shot 33.3 percent from three-point range.

**STANFORD TO PLAY IN SHANGHAI IN 2016**

Stanford will open the 2016-17 season against Harvard in the 2016 Pac-12 China game, scheduled to be played in Shanghai on Nov. 12, 2016, Pac-12 Commissioner Larry Scott announced on Nov. 13. The game, which will be televised live back in the United States on Nov. 11, will tip off the 2016-17 men's basketball season. The 2016 Pac-12 China Game will be presented by Alibaba Group with Federation of University Sports of China (FUSC), which operates under China's Ministry of Education, serving as the co-host for the game.

**CARDINAL IN THE NBA**

Five former Stanford standouts – Brook Lopez (Brooklyn Nets), Robin Lopez (New York Knicks), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Josh Huestis (Oklahoma City Thunder) and Anthony Brown (Los Angeles Lakers) – opened the 2015-16 season on NBA rosters. Powell, Huestis and Brown all played under head coach Johnny Dawkins. Brook Lopez leads the Nets in scoring (19.7 ppg) and ranks second on Brooklyn's roster in rebounds (8.5 rpg). Dwight Powell, in his second year in the NBA, is averaging 7.4 ppg and 5.4 rpg for the Dallas Mavericks.

**TOUR OF ITALY**

Stanford enjoyed a 17-day tour of Italy from Aug. 19-Sept. 4, playing six exhibition games against some of the country's top professional teams. The program also had an opportunity to explore the country, visiting Rome, Florence, Venice, Bologna, Como and Pesaro during its exhibition tour.

**STANBACK JOINS CARDINAL**

Trevor Stanback, regarded as one of the highest-rated prospects on the West Coast, has signed a National Letter of Intent with Stanford on Nov. 12. Stanback, a 6-10, 220-pound power forward from Maranatha High School in Pasadena, Calif., is a consensus four-star prospect by the major recruiting services. He ranks as the 13th-best power forward in the nation by Scout.com and is a member of the Rivals100 for the Class of 2016. Scout.com ranks the power forward as the third-best prospect in the state of California, while ESPN's recruiting service has him as the ninth-best prospect in the Golden State. He is rated the 18th-best power forward in the nation by 247Sports.

Johnny Dawkins' contributions since arriving on The Farm have come in the form of both team and individual success, most notably guiding the Cardinal to the 2014 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 and the 2012 Postseason NIT championship.

Meanwhile, Dawkins has also been responsible for overseeing the development of Landry Fields, Josh Huestis and Dwight Powell, all of whom parlayed outstanding senior seasons into NBA Draft selections. Huestis (first round) and Powell (second round) were taken in the first round of the 2014 NBA Draft while Fields (second round) was chosen in 2010.

Dawkins has also made significant strides off the court, with the 2014 recruiting class representing the latest top-20 crop of freshmen to arrive on The Farm. Even more impressively, that same young talent is being developed quickly. In 2012, Chasson Randle became the fourth player to earn All-Freshman Team status among conference players during Dawkins' tenure following a six-year period in which only two Cardinal rookies were honored.

A very high standard in the classroom has also been established during Dawkins' tenure. In 2013-14, Stanford totaled the most Pac-12 All-Academic selections (6) of any conference school for the fifth consecutive season while Powell and Randle were tabbed back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athletes of the Year.

The 2013-14 campaign was especially memorable, as Stanford (23-13, 10-8 Pac-12) advanced to the Sweet 16 for only the fifth time in school history after upsets of No. 7 seed New Mexico and No. 2 seed Kansas. Despite losing two starters and two key reserves to season-ending injuries, the Cardinal finished tied for third in the highly-competitive Pac-12.

Stanford finished 19-15 overall two seasons ago, advancing to the NIT second round. The Cardinal finished 9-9 in the Pac-12, swept the season series against California for the first time since 2008 and notched a 76-52 home upset of No. 10/12 Oregon.

Stanford produced a 26-11 record in 2011-12 en route to capturing the Postseason NIT title, the third championship in school history. The Cardinal chalked up its best win total since a 28-8 campaign in 2007-08. Stanford was the Pac-12's winningest program and tallied a league-best four top-50 RPI victories.

The Cardinal concluded the 2010-11 season at 15-16, fielding a team without a senior for the first time in school history. Stanford finished 14-18 during the 2009-10 campaign, Dawkins' second year at the helm.

In 2008-09, Dawkins directed Stanford to a 20-14 record and reached the CBI semifinals. In addition to surpassing Robert Burnett as the winningest first-year head coach in school history, Dawkins ranked third in victories among 21 first-year head coaches in Division I with no prior college head coaching experience.

Dawkins, 52, became Stanford's 17th head coach on April 28, 2008, after 11 years as an assistant at Duke.

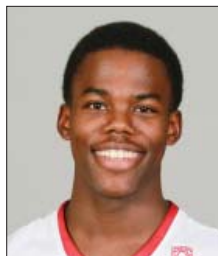
