ACADEMIC SPOTLIGHT

Senior Grant Verhoeven – Earth Systems major

Focusing on sustainable food and agriculture

Project

Grant and his group traveled to Watsonville, Calif., where they used Electrical Resistivity Tomography (a series of electrodes which are metal spikes about a foot into the ground) to send electrical signals from spike to spike. Through this, the group studied the frequency of each electrical signal to determine the type of soil.

The area in Watsonville, close the ocean, allowed Grant to study the effects of the drought in the ground. Because of lack of rain water, farmers had to use a lot of groundwater for irrigation. As they extracted the groundwater in the wells, they noticed the barrier is breaking between the ocean water and groundwater aquifer, creating a problem called Saltwater Intrusion. In some instances, the water pulled up from the well was saltwater. Grant and his group tried to determine how far the saltwater was on the property.

TRIP TO THE EVERGREEN STATE

Coming off a 76-72 victory over No. 11/12 Oregon this past Saturday, Stanford hits the road this week with a trip to the Evergreen State. The Cardinal will face Washington State Thursday at 7 p.m. in Pullman and Washington Saturday at 5 p.m. in Seattle. Stanford will play four of its final six regular-season games on the road, closing the regular-season slate against Arizona State and Arizona in the Grand Canyon state.

ROSCO ALLEN'S LAST SIX GAMES

Senior Rosco Allen (15.4 ppg overall) is averaging 19.7 ppg in his last six contests. Allen has led or tied for the team lead in scoring in each of the last six games. Five of his six career 20-point games have come in the last 10 contests, including a career-high tying 25 points at Colorado and against No. 11 Oregon.

ALLEN'S SECOND-HALF PRODUCTION

Of Rosco Allen's 118 total points in his last six games, 86 have come in the second half, including 20 points in the second period at Colorado on Jan. 27 and all 16 in the final period at California on Feb. 6.

SHEFFIELD IN PAC-12 PLAY

Freshman Marcus Sheffield is averaging 9.9 points in 25.4 minutes per game in 11 Pac-12 contests, after averaging 4.0 points in 11.2 minutes in the Cardinal's 11 nonconference games. Sheffield was inserted into the starting lineup three games ago.

MOST STEALS IN 19 YEARS

Stanford's 6.9 steals-per-game average is its highest since the 1996-97 season (6.9 spg). With 159 steals already this season, the Cardinal is on pace to record at least 200 steals for the fourth time in the last five seasons. The 6.9 spg average is fourth-best in the Pac-12.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Stanford has played the second-toughest schedule in the nation, according to ESPN's Daily RPI on Feb. 16. The Cardinal has played four top-25 teams, with victories over No. 21/22 Utah on Jan. 1 and No. 11/12 Oregon last time out. Stanford has four RPI top-40 wins already with victories over Oregon (4), Utah (16), California (23) and Oregon State (38) in the RPI rankings on Feb. 16.

AGAINST WASHINGTON STATE

Stanford leads the all-time series, 74-60, and has won five of the last six meetings between the two teams. The Cardinal had its five-game winning streak against the Cougars snapped with an 89-88 setback in Pullman, Wash. on Jan. 31 of last season. Stanford is 2-4 against Washington State in Pullman in the Johnny Dawkins era.

LAST TIME OUT

Senior Rosco Allen matched his career-high with 25 points, making four of five from long range to lead Stanford to a 76-72 upset over No. 11 Oregon. Dorian Pickens scored 10 of his 16 points in the second half and Grant Verhoeven finished with a career-high 13 for the Cardinal, who improved to 2-2 against ranked opponents. The game remained in doubt until Michael Humphrey blocked a shot with four seconds remaining and junior Marcus Allen hit two free throws with three seconds to seal the win for the Cardinal.

AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

The Cardinal is 2-2 against top-25 teams this season and 13-22 against ranked foes in the Johnny Dawkins era. Stanford defeated No. 11 Oregon (76-72) on Feb. 13 and No. 21 Utah (70-68) on Jan. 1, while dropping decisions to No. 8/9 Villanova (59-45) on Nov. 27 and No. 12/11 Arizona (71-57) on Jan. 21.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Nearly five guys are averaging double figures in the scoring column for the Cardinal. Rosco Allen (15.4), Reid Travis (12.8), Marcus Allen (11.5) and Dorian Pickens (11.4) have averaged double figures throughout the season, while Michael Humphrey (9.1) dipped below his double-digit average after being limited with a thigh injury the last three contests. There has not been a Stanford team with five individuals averaging double figures, dating back to the 1948-49 season.

THE LINEUP

Stanford has presented a different starting lineup in each of its last three games after utilizing the same lineup the previous 12 contests. Freshman Marcus Sheffield has started the last three, while Grant Verhoeven earned the start at center at Cal and against Oregon. Senior Rosco Allen is the lone Cardinal to have started all 23 games this season. Marcus Allen came off the bench for the first time in 18 games and Dorian Pickens came off the bench for the first time in 13 contests last time out against Oregon. In all, Stanford has used nine different lineups in its 23 games.

HOME SWEET HOME

Stanford has won at least 10 home games for 23 straight seasons, dating back to 1992-93. The Cardinal has won 13 of its last 17 home games and owns a 102-35 record at Maples Pavilion under Johnny Dawkins.

ROSCO ALLEN FROM DEEP

Rosco Allen ranks seventh in the Pac-12 in three-point field goals made (2.0). He has recorded at least one three-point field goal in each of the last 18 games and has posted multiple three-pointers in seven of the last 10 games. The senior ranks sixth in scoring in the Pac-12 (16.8 ppg) during conference games and 10th (15.4 ppg) overall.

VERHOEVEN A FORCE INSIDE THE PAINT AND FROM DOWNTOWN

Senior Grant Verhoeven has scored 53 of his 67 points on the season in the last seven games. The senior (averaging 3.4 ppg overall) is averaging 11.5 ppg in his last two games. He posted a career-best 13 in a career-long 32 minutes last time out against No. 11 Oregon. He had 10 points against Oregon State two days prior. Verhoeven increased his career-best point total in four of the last seven games. After not attempting a three-pointer in his first 74 career games, he is 2-for-2 from beyond the arc in his last six contests.

HUMPHREY STEPPING UP WITH TRAVIS OUT

Sophomore Michael Humphrey is averaging 9.5 ppg in his last 15 contests, playing without fellow starting forward Reid Travis (out indefinitely with a stress reaction in his leg). He ranks eighth in the Pac-12 in blocks (1.3 bpg), including a key block of Oregon's Dillon Brooks in the final seconds to seal the win over the Ducks Feb. 13. Humphrey has two double-doubles (13 pts., 11 rebs. vs. Green Bay, 13 pts., 12 rebs. vs. Charleston Southern) on the season.

MARCUS ALLEN EXCELLING ON BOTH ENDS OF THE COURT

Junior Marcus Allen ranks second in scoring among the Cardinal's regular contributors, averaging 11.5 ppg. He also ranks third in the Pac-12 in steals (1.7). The guard recorded his first double-double of the season with 16 points and 10 rebounds in the win over California on Jan. 14.

PICKENS PROVIDES SCORING PUNCH

Sophomore Dorian Pickens ranks second on the Cardinal in three-pointers with 34 this season. He is shooting 34.6 percent from beyond the arc. The guard also ranks sixth on the roster in scoring among regular starters at 11.2 ppg. Pickens had a career-best 24 points (on six three-pointers) against Texas. He posted his first career double-double, with 11 points and a career-best 10 rebounds vs. No. 8 Villanova. The sophomore, who is averaging 29.1 minutes this year, averaged 2.1 points in 9.8 minutes last season.

SANDERS WITH THE ASSIST

Senior Christian Sanders did what no Cardinal had done in nearly four years. The point guard recorded 10 assists in Stanford's victory over No. 11 Oregon last Saturday. Saturday's assist total (a career-best for Sanders) was the first time a Cardinal posted double digit assists in a game since Jarrett Mann had 10 at Oregon State on Feb. 24, 2011. He leads the Cardinal, averaging 2.7 apg.

FRESHMAN TRIO SEEING MORE TIME ON THE COURT

Stanford's three freshmen - Josh Sharma, Marcus Sheffield and Cameron Walker - have each seen their minutes increase in the last five games. Sharma, averaging 6.6 minutes overall, has averaged nearly nine in his last five games. Walker, averaging 9.2 minutes overall, has averaged 11.6 minutes in the last five. Sheffield, averaging 18.6 minutes overall, has averaged 27.4 minutes in his last five. He has started the Cardinal's last three games.

KIM BELTON TO BE INDUCTED INTO THE PAC-12 HALL OF HONOR

A standout performer from 1977-80, Kim Belton will be one of 12 former student-athletes to be inducted into the Pac-12 Hall of Honor March 12 in Las Vegas. A three-time all-conference honoree, he ranks among the top-seven in both scoring and rebounding in Stanford history. His scoring total of 1,615 ranks seventh all-time while his scoring average of 15.0 ppg is good for 16th. Belton's 628 field goals rank fourth-best in school history. A prolific shot-blocker as well, Belton's 86 career blocks are 11th-best in program history. He has enjoyed a successful career as a producer for ESPN/ABC overseeing studio shows and event broadcasts for the network.

QUARTERBACKS TURNED POST PLAYERS

Sophomore forwards Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey were each the quarterback of their high school football team. Travis was the signal caller for three years at DeLaSalle HS in Minnesota, before deciding to focus on basketball his senior year. Humphrey was the starting quarterback at Sunnyslope HS in Phoenix.

TRI-CAPTAINS

Senior Rosco Allen, junior Marcus Allen and sophomore Reid Travis were voted captains for the 2015-16 season. Combined, the trio has played in 216 career games.

BROOKLYN COMEBACK

Stanford erased a 17-point deficit (48-65) with 6:11 to play, scoring 21 of the game's final 22 points to earn a 69-66 come-from-behind victory over Arkansas in the NIT Season Tip-Off Nov. 27 at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn. Senior Rosco Allen scored eight of his career-high 25 points in the final 4:27 of the game.

CONTROLLING THE GLASS

Stanford's 55 rebounds against Villanova in the NIT Season Tip-Off on Nov. 26 were the most by the Cardinal in the Johnny Dawkins era. Dawkins, in his eighth season as head coach of the Cardinal, has seen Stanford record 50 or more rebounds in a game six times.

CARTWRIGHT SIDELINED FOR SEASON

Sophomore guard Robert Cartwright sustained a compound fracture in his right arm and will miss the 2015-16 season. The injury occurred during Stanford's team practice at Maples Pavilion on Nov. 2. Cartwright played in all but one game, earning one start, as a freshman during Stanford's 2015 Postseason NIT Championship run. The point guard averaged 1.9 points in 11.1 minutes per game. He shot 33.3 percent from three-point range.

STANFORD TO PLAY IN SHANGHAI

Stanford will open the 2016-17 season against Harvard in the Pac-12 China game, scheduled to be played in Shanghai on Nov. 12, 2016, Pac-12 Commissioner Larry Scott announced on Nov. 13. The game, which will be televised live back in the United States on Nov. 11, will tip off the season. The 2016 Pac-12 China Game will be presented by Alibaba Group with Federation of University Sports of China (FUSC), which operates under China's Ministry of Education, serving as the co-host for the game.

CARDINAL IN THE NBA

Five former Stanford standouts – Brook Lopez (Brooklyn Nets), Robin Lopez (New York Knicks), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Josh Huestis (Oklahoma City Thunder) and Anthony Brown (Los Angeles Lakers) – opened the 2015-16 season on NBA rosters. Powell, Huestis and Brown all played under head coach Johnny Dawkins. Entering the NBA All-Star break, Brook Lopez leads the Nets in scoring (20.2 ppg) and ranks second on the roster in rebounds (8.2 rpg). Dwight Powell, in his second year in the NBA, is averaging 6.7 ppg and 4.6 rpg for the Dallas Mavericks. Powell played recorded a double-double (12 points and 11 rebounds) in the NBA Rising Stars Challenge at the NBA All-Star game in Toronto on Feb. 12. The Rising Stars Challenge showcased the top talent among first and second-year players in the league. In his rookie season with the Lakers, Brown is averaging 3.8 ppg and 2.2 rpg over 25 contests.

TOUR OF ITALY

Stanford enjoyed a 17-day tour of Italy from Aug. 19-Sept. 4, playing six exhibition games against some of the country's top professional teams. The program also had an opportunity to explore the country, visiting Rome, Florence, Venice, Bologna, Como and Pesaro during its exhibition tour.

STANBACK JOINS CARDINAL

Trevor Stanback, regarded as one of the highest-rated prospects on the West Coast, signed a National Letter of Intent with Stanford. Stanback, a 6-10, 220-pound power forward from Maranatha High School in Pasadena, Calif., is a consensus four-star prospect by the major recruiting services. He ranks as the 13th-best power forward in the nation by Scout.com and is a member of the Rivals100 for the Class of 2016. Scout.com ranks the power forward as the third-best prospect in the state of California.

Johnny Dawkins' contributions since arriving on The Farm have come in the form of both team and individual success, most notably guiding the Cardinal to the 2014 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 and the 2012 Postseason NIT championship.

Meanwhile, Dawkins has also been responsible for overseeing the development of Landry Fields, Josh Huestis and Dwight Powell, all of whom parlayed outstanding senior seasons into NBA Draft selections. Huestis (first round) and Powell (second round) were taken in the first round of the 2014 NBA Draft while Fields (second round) was chosen in 2010.

Dawkins has also made significant strides off the court, with the 2014 recruiting class representing the latest top-20 crop of freshmen to arrive on The Farm. Even more impressively, that same young talent is being developed quickly. In 2012, Chasson Randle became the fourth player to earn All-Freshman Team status among conference players during Dawkins' tenure following a six-year period in which only two Cardinal rookies were honored.

A very high standard in the classroom has also been established during Dawkins' tenure. In 2013-14, Stanford totaled the most Pac-12 All-Academic selections (6) of any conference school for the fifth consecutive season while Powell and Randle were tabbed back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athletes of the Year.

The 2013-14 campaign was especially memorable, as Stanford (23-13, 10-8 Pac-12) advanced to the Sweet 16 for only the fifth time in school history after upsets of No. 7 seed New Mexico and No. 2 seed Kansas. Despite losing two starters and two key reserves to season-ending injuries, the Cardinal finished tied for third in the highly-competitive Pac-12.

Stanford finished 19-15 overall two seasons ago, advancing to the NIT second round. The Cardinal finished 9-9 in the Pac-12, swept the season series against California for the first time since 2008 and notched a 76-52 home upset of No. 10/12 Oregon.

Stanford produced a 26-11 record in 2011-12 en route to capturing the Postseason NIT title, the third championship in school history. The Cardinal chalked up its best win total since a 28-8 campaign in 2007-08. Stanford was the Pac-12's winningest program and tallied a league-best four top-50 RPI victories.

The Cardinal concluded the 2010-11 season at 15-16, fielding a team without a senior for the first time in school history. Stanford finished 14-18 during the 2009-10 campaign, Dawkins' second year at the helm.

In 2008-09, Dawkins directed Stanford to a 20-14 record and reached the CBI semifinals. In addition to surpassing Robert Burnett as the winningest first-year head coach in school history, Dawkins ranked third in victories among 21 first-year head coaches in Division I with no prior college head coaching experience.

Dawkins, 52, became Stanford's 17th head coach on April 28, 2008, after 11 years as an assistant at Duke.


