FINAL HOMESTAND

Stanford hosts USC on Thursday (Feb. 25) and UCLA on Saturday (Feb. 27) in its final regular-season homestand. Games 15 and 16 of the Pac-12 slate will be the first time the Cardinal will face USC and UCLA. A result of Pac-12 scheduling this season, Stanford will not play at USC for the first time since the 1956-57 campaign. The Cardinal will also be missing a trip to Westwood for the first time since the 1955-56 season. Stanford last faced USC on Feb. 8 of last season, a 70-62 victory at Maples Pavilion.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Stanford has played the fourth-toughest schedule in the nation, according to ESPN's Daily RPI on Feb. 23. The Cardinal has played four top-25 teams, with wins over No. 21/22 Utah and No. 11/12 Oregon. Stanford has four RPI top-35 wins already with victories over Oregon (3), Utah (10), California (19) and Oregon State (35) in the RPI rankings on Feb. 23.

AGAINST USC

Stanford holds a 124-123 edge in the all-time series. The Cardinal has won the last four games in the series. USC has not won at Maples Pavilion since Feb. 14, 2013. Stanford's current roster is a combined 19-4 against USC in their careers. Seniors Rosco Allen, Grant Verhoeven and Christian Sanders are the lone members of the Cardinal to have played in a loss against the Trojans. Stanford is 8-6 against USC in the Johnny Dawkins era.

HUMPHREY'S PERFORMANCE AT WASHINGTON ST. ONE OF COLLEGE BASKETBALL'S BEST

Sophomore Michael Humphrey scored a career-high 26 points - the most by a Stanford player this season - at Washington State (Feb. 18). He also collected 10 rebounds, a career-best four steals, and three blocks in a career-long 37 minutes. The performance came after he had been limited to 34 total minutes over the previous three games with a thigh injury. Humphrey is one of only seven players in the last five seasons to record at least 25 points, 10 rebounds, four steals and three blocks in a game.

BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Nearly five guys are averaging double figures in the scoring column for the Cardinal. Rosco Allen (15.6), Dorian Pickens (11.4), Marcus Allen (11.2) and Reid Travis (12.8) have averaged double figures, while Michael Humphrey has averaged 9.6 ppg. Travis played in the first eight games before missing the remainder of the season. There has not been a Stanford team with five individuals averaging double figures, dating back to the 1948-49 season.

HOME SWEET HOME

Stanford has won at least 10 home games for 23 straight seasons, dating back to 1992-93. The Cardinal has won 13 of its last 17 home games and owns a 102-35 record at Maples Pavilion under Johnny Dawkins.

THE LINEUP

Stanford has presented a different starting lineup in four of its last five games after utilizing the same lineup the previous 12 contests. Senior Rosco Allen is the lone Cardinal to have started all 25 games this season. Senior Grant Verhoeven has started three of the last four contests. Marcus Allen came off the bench for the first time in 18 games and Dorian Pickens came off the bench for the first time in 13 contests against Oregon. In all, Stanford has used nine different lineups in its 25 games.

MORE MINUTES... MORE POINTS

The group of Rosco Allen, Marcus Allen, Michael Humphrey and Dorian Pickens combined to average 23.7 points in 69.1 (17.3 per player) minutes per game last season. That same group is averaging a combined 47.8 points in 119.2 (29.8 per player) minutes this year.

SHEFFIELD IN PAC-12 PLAY

Freshman Marcus Sheffield is averaging 9.2 points in 23.6 minutes per game in 13 Pac-12 contests, after averaging 4.0 points in 11.2 minutes in the Cardinal's 11 nonconference games.

ROSCO ALLEN FROM DEEP

Rosco Allen ranks seventh in the Pac-12 in three-point field goals made (2.0). He has recorded at least one three-point field goal in each of the last 20 games and has posted multiple three-pointers in eight of the last 12 games. The senior ranks sixth in scoring in the Pac-12 (16.9 ppg) during conference games and 10th (15.6 ppg) overall.

VERHOEVEN FROM DOWNTOWN

After not attempting a three-pointer in his first 74 career games, senior center Grant Verhoeven is 3-for-4 from beyond the arc in his last eight contests. He has scored 58 of his 72 points on the season in the last nine games. The senior, averaging 3.3 ppg overall, is averaging 7.0 ppg in his last four games. He had a career-best 13 in a career-long 32 minutes against No. 11 Oregon.

HUMPHREY STEPPING UP WITH TRAVIS OUT

Stanford opened the season with a starting frontcourt of sophomores Reid Travis and Michael Humphrey. Travis sustained a leg injury and was forced to the sidelines after just eight games. Here is a look at Humphrey's play in the last 17 games since Travis was forced to the sidelines.

Humphrey also ranks eighth in the Pac-12 in blocks (1.3 bpg), including a key block of Oregon's Dillon Brooks in the final seconds to seal the win over the Ducks Feb. 13. Humphrey has three double-doubles on the season.

MARCUS ALLEN EXCELLING ON BOTH ENDS OF THE COURT

Junior Marcus Allen ranks third on the team in scoring, averaging 11.2 ppg. He also ranks fourth in the Pac-12 in steals (1.5). The guard recorded his first double-double of the year with 16 points and 10 rebounds in the win over California on Jan. 14.

PICKENS PROVIDES SCORING PUNCH

Sophomore Dorian Pickens ranks second on the Cardinal in three-pointers with 40 this season. The guard also ranks second on the roster in scoring among regular starters at 11.5 ppg. Pickens had a career-best 24 points (on six three-pointers) against Texas. He posted his first career doubledouble, with 11 points and a career-best 10 rebounds vs. No. 8 Villanova.

SANDERS WITH THE ASSIST

Senior Christian Sanders did what no Cardinal had done in nearly four years. The point guard recorded 10 assists in the victory over No. 11 Oregon Feb. 13. The assist total (a career-best for Sanders) was the first time a Cardinal posted double digit assists in a game since Jarrett Mann had 10 at Oregon State on Feb. 24, 2011.

KIM BELTON TO BE INDUCTED INTO THE PAC-12 HALL OF HONOR

A standout performer from 1977-80, Kim Belton will be one of 12 former student-athletes to be inducted into the Pac-12 Hall of Honor March 12 in Las Vegas. A three-time all-conference honoree, he ranks among the top-seven in both scoring and rebounding in Stanford history. His scoring total of 1,615 ranks seventh all-time while his scoring average of 15.0 ppg is good for 16th. Belton's 628 field goals rank fourth-best in school history. A prolific shot-blocker as well, Belton's 86 career blocks are 11th-best in program history. He has enjoyed a successful career as a producer for ESPN/ABC overseeing studio shows and event broadcasts for the network.

TRI-CAPTAINS

Senior Rosco Allen, junior Marcus Allen and sophomore Reid Travis were voted captains for the 2015-16 season. Combined, the trio has played in 220 career games.

BROOKLYN COMEBACK

Stanford erased a 17-point deficit (48-65) with 6:11 to play, scoring 21 of the game's final 22 points to earn a 69-66 come-from-behind victory over Arkansas in the NIT Season Tip-Off Nov. 27 at the Barclays Center in Brooklyn. Senior Rosco Allen scored eight of his career-high 25 points in the final 4:27 of the game.

TRAVIS OUT FOR REMAINDER OF THE SEASON

Sophomore forward Reid Travis, who started the first eight games and averaged 12.8 ppg and 7.1 rpg, is forced to miss the remainder of the season with a leg injury sustained in the middle of December.

CARTWRIGHT SIDELINED FOR THE YEAR

Sophomore guard Robert Cartwright sustained a compound fracture in his right arm and will miss the 2015-16 season. The injury occurred during Stanford's team practice at Maples Pavilion on Nov. 2. Cartwright played in all but one game, earning one start, as a freshman during Stanford's 2015 Postseason NIT Championship run. The point guard averaged 1.9 points in 11.1 minutes per game. He shot 33.3 percent from three-point range.

STANFORD TO PLAY IN SHANGHAI

Stanford will open the 2016-17 season against Harvard in the Pac-12 China game, scheduled to be played in Shanghai on Nov. 12, 2016, Pac-12 Commissioner Larry Scott announced on Nov. 13. The game, which will be televised live back in the United States on Nov. 11, will tip off the season.

CARDINAL IN THE NBA

Five former Stanford standouts – Brook Lopez (Brooklyn Nets), Robin Lopez (New York Knicks), Dwight Powell (Dallas Mavericks), Josh Huestis (Oklahoma City Thunder) and Anthony Brown (Los Angeles Lakers) – opened the 2015-16 season on NBA rosters. Powell, Huestis and Brown all played under head coach Johnny Dawkins. Entering the NBA All-Star break, Brook Lopez leads the Nets in scoring (20.6 ppg) and ranks second on the roster in rebounds (8.3 rpg). Dwight Powell, in his second year in the NBA, is averaging 6.6 ppg and 4.5 rpg for the Dallas Mavericks. Powell played recorded a double-double (12 points and 11 rebounds) in the NBA Rising Stars Challenge at the NBA All-Star game in Toronto on Feb. 12. The Rising Stars Challenge showcased the top talent among first and second-year players in the league. In his rookie season with the Lakers, Brown is averaging 3.8 ppg and 2.2 rpg over 25 contests.

TOUR OF ITALY

Stanford enjoyed a 17-day tour of Italy from Aug. 19-Sept. 4, playing six exhibition games against some of the country's top professional teams. The program also had an opportunity to explore the country, visiting Rome, Florence, Venice, Bologna, Como and Pesaro during its exhibition tour.

STANBACK JOINS CARDINAL

Trevor Stanback, regarded as one of the highest-rated prospects on the West Coast, signed a National Letter of Intent with Stanford. Stanback, a 6-10, 220-pound power forward from Maranatha High School in Pasadena, Calif., is a consensus four-star prospect by the major recruiting services. He ranks as the 13th-best power forward in the nation by Scout.com and is a member of the Rivals100 for the Class of 2016. Scout.com ranks the power forward as the third-best prospect in the state of California.

Johnny Dawkins' contributions since arriving on The Farm have come in the form of both team and individual success, most notably guiding the Cardinal to the 2014 NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 and the 2012 Postseason NIT championship.

Meanwhile, Dawkins has also been responsible for overseeing the development of Landry Fields, Josh Huestis and Dwight Powell, all of whom parlayed outstanding senior seasons into NBA Draft selections. Huestis (first round) and Powell (second round) were taken in the first round of the 2014 NBA Draft while Fields (second round) was chosen in 2010.

Dawkins has also made significant strides off the court, with the 2014 recruiting class representing the latest top-20 crop of freshmen to arrive on The Farm. Even more impressively, that same young talent is being developed quickly. In 2012, Chasson Randle became the fourth player to earn All-Freshman Team status among conference players during Dawkins' tenure following a six-year period in which only two Cardinal rookies were honored.

A very high standard in the classroom has also been established during Dawkins' tenure. In 2013-14, Stanford totaled the most Pac-12 All-Academic selections (6) of any conference school for the fifth consecutive season while Powell and Randle were tabbed back-to-back Pac-12 Scholar-Athletes of the Year.

The 2013-14 campaign was especially memorable, as Stanford (23-13, 10-8 Pac-12) advanced to the Sweet 16 for only the fifth time in school history after upsets of No. 7 seed New Mexico and No. 2 seed Kansas. Despite losing two starters and two key reserves to season-ending injuries, the Cardinal finished tied for third in the highlycompetitive Pac-12.

Stanford finished 19-15 overall two seasons ago, advanc-

ing to the NIT second round. The Cardinal finished 9-9 in the Pac-12, swept the season series against California for the first time since 2008 and notched a 76-52 home upset of No. 10/12 Oregon.

league-best four top-50 RPI victories.

The Cardinal concluded the 2010-11 season at 15-16, fielding a team without a senior for the first time in school history. Stanford finished 14-18 during the 2009-10 campaign, Dawkins' second year at the helm.

In 2008-09, Dawkins directed Stanford to a 20-14 record and reached the CBI semifinals. In addition to surpassing Robert Burnett as the winningest first-year head coach in school history, Dawkins ranked third in victories among 21 first-year head coaches in Division I with no prior college head coaching experience.

Dawkins, 52, became Stanford's 17th head coach on April 28, 2008, after 11 years as an assistant at Duke.
