Stanford takes on five teams at Mary Nutter Classic

STANFORD, Calif. – Stanford travels to Southern California for five games this weekend at the Mary Nutter Classic in Cathedral City.

The Cardinal (4-5) takes on its first ranked opponent of the season in its tournament-opener against No. 17/12 Missouri (6-0) on Thursday at 3:30 p.m. (PT). Stanford will also take on San Jose State, Boise State, NC State and San Diego State during the weekend.

The Cardinal is coming off a challenging home-opening weekend, going 1-3 with its lone win coming against St. Mary's. Victoria Molina led Stanford offensively, going 5-for-13 (.385) with five RBIs, a home run, a double, a run and a .692 slugging percentage.

Arden Pettit (.375) and Bessie Noll (.364) also had nice weekends at the plate. Noll produced the defensive highlight of the weekend in the final game of the tournament when she threw out a runner at home from center field.

NOLL PROVIDES POWER

- Junior centerfielder Bessie Noll continued her hot start to the season, going 4-for-11 (.364) with two doubles, four walks, two runs, an RBI over four games at the Stanford Nike Invitational.

- Noll hit three home runs in the first two games of the season to power Stanford's offense. She finished the first weekend of the year 5-for-16 (.313) with five runs, four RBIs, two walks and a .938 slugging percentage.

- Noll grew up playing baseball in Tokyo, Japan, and only played softball during the summer of her high school years.

VICTORY MOLINA

- Victoria Molina led Stanford offensively at the Nike Invitational, going 5-for-13 (.385) with five RBIs, a home run, a double, a run and a .692 slugging percentage. She hit a three-run home run in the bottom of the sixth inning against St. Mary's (Feb. 21) to erase a 4-1 deficit and help send the game to extra innings.

- As a freshman, Molina hit a two-run walk-off home run in the bottom of the ninth inning against No. 24/23 Arizona State to propel Stanford to a dramatic 4-2 victory. Three of her four hits last season were home runs.

PICKING UP WHERE SHE LEFT OFF

- Kayla Bonstrom (international relations), a 2015 NFCA All-America Second Team selection, picked up where she left off last season and hit .429 (6-for-14) during the season-opening Kajikawa Classic. She went 4-for-14 (.286) with two RBIs, two runs, two doubles and a walk at the Stanford Nike Invitational.

- Bonstrom was named to the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Top-50 Watch List earlier this season. She was also selected as a Senior CLASS Award Top-30 finalist.

- Bonstrom was a force at the plate and led Stanford in every major offensive category throughout the 2015 season. She was named a NFCA Second Team All-American, NFCA All-West Region First Team at first base, All-Pac-12 First Team and a Pac-12 All-Defensive Team honorable mention.

- Bonstrom had at least one hit in 40-of-54 games (74 percent) and registered a hit in 23 of her final 34 contests, accumulating 42 hits during that span.

- Bonstrom set the Stanford single-season slugging percentage record at .806 – becoming the first Cardinal player to break the .800 mark. She finished in the top-11 in multiple single-season categories in Stanford history including: batting average (5th, .439), home runs (T-5th, 13), RBI (T-7th, 54), doubles (11th, 16) and fielding percentage (T-2nd, .997). She was solid defensively, committing just one error in 381 chances.

- Bonstrom finished the 2015 regular season ranked 41st in the nation in batting average (.439), 24th in on-base percentage (.549) and 39th in slugging percentage (.806). She finished in the top-10 among Pac-12 players in multiple categories, including: on-base percentage (4th, .549), batting average (5th, .439), slugging percentage (5th, .806), doubles (T-5th, 16), hits (T-6th, 68), total bases (T-7th, 125), RBI (10th, 54) and putouts (2nd, 365).

- Bonstrom excelled in the classroom as well and was a 2015 Capital One Academic Second Team All-American and All-District Softball Team District 8 selection. She was selected to the Center for International Security and Cooperation (CISAC) Interscholar Honors Program in International Security Studies to develop a senior thesis with the federal government related to national security. She's interested in working in national security upon graduation.

PETTIT MAKING NOISE

- Sophomore Arden Pettit has as a quality start to her second season and is hitting .417 with four runs and a walk through the first two weekends. She hit .375 (3-for-8) this past weekend at the Stanford Nike Invitational.

- Pettit was one of 22 athletes to receive an invitation to try out for the 2015 USA Softball Junior Women's (19-Under) National Team. She was named an alternate to the team at the conclusion of the camp and spent time with the team this past summer.

IN THE CIRCLE

- Sophomore Haley Snyder and freshman Carolyn Lee will be the focal points in the circle. Snyder made 29 appearances (15 starts), picking up 38 strikeouts in 112.2 innings before she was sidelined by an injury.

- Lee was a 2015 Cal-Hi Sports All-State third team selection from nearby Dougherty Valley High School and is expected to play a major role beginning early in the season. Sophomore Kaitlyn Lagattuta will likely see some innings in the circle as relief.

SORENSEN STARTS STRONG

• Kylie Sorenson had a strong opening weekend at the Kajikawa Classic, hitting .467 (7-for-15) with five RBIs, five runs, five walks, a home run and a .667 slugging percentage.

2015 IN REVIEW

• Stanford battled through injuries and adversity during the 2015 season but produced a number of highlight moments en route to a 17-37 record and 2-22 mark in the Pac-12. The Cardinal defeated five NCAA Tournament teams, recorded single-season top 10 numbers in multiple offensive categories and saw one of the best single-season individual performances in program history by Kayla Bonstrom.

• Stanford picked up victories against NCAA Tournament teams No. 3/4 Alabama, No. 24/23 Arizona State, RV/25 Texas, Utah and Weber State.

• The Cardinal was strong offensively, finishing the season in the top-10 in program history in walks (T-6th, 198), home runs (8th, 39), triples (8th, 11), slugging percentage (9th, .422) and RBI (10th, 259).

ALL-PAC-12 CONFERENCE

• Kayla Bonstrom earned 2015 All-Pac-12 First Team honors, while Erin Ashby, Kylie Sorenson and Tylyn Wells received honorable mention recognition.

PAC-12 ALL-DEFENSE

• Jessica Plaza earned 2015 Pac-12 All-Defense recognition. She registered a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage for the second consecutive season. Plaza is one of two Stanford players all-time to record a perfect fielding percentage.

PAC-12 ALL-FRESHMAN TEAM

• Victoria Molina was named a 2015 Pac-12 All-Freshman Team honorable mention. She provided one of Stanford's most dramatic moments of the year when she hit a ninth inning two-run walk-off home run against No. 24/23 Arizona State.

IT'S ALL ACADEMIC

• Stanford softball student-athletes accumulated eight 2015 Pac-12 All-Academic honors, including a conference-best five members on the first and second teams. Kayla Bonstrom was named to the first team, while Lauren Bertoy, Bessie Noll, Kaitlin Schaberg and Kylie Sorenson were second-team selections. Erin Ashby, Madi Schreyer and Tylyn Wells each earned honorable mention recognition.

• Stanford softball was one of 19 Cardinal teams to receive a Division I Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Awards from the NCAA.

STANFORD AWARD WINNERS

• Stanford players voted on awards for teammates after the 2015 season and selected Kayla Bonstrom as the Most Valuable Player and Kylie Sorenson as the Defensive Most Valuable Player. Kaitlyn Lagattuta earned the Tough as Nails Award and the Highest Grade Point Average Award.
