It doesn't get any easier for Stanford this week with No. 2 Vanderbilt coming to The Farm and weather wreaking havoc on the series schedule.

• Overall (first meeting in 1973): 6-7 (.462) | Streak: Vanderbilt, 1

• Stanford and Vanderbilt first met on March 30, 1973 at the UC Riverside Invitational. The Cardinal shut out Vanderbilt. 6-0.

• Vanderbilt has won five of the last six in this series—all of which came in 2014. The Commodores swept the Cardinal in a three-game set in Nashville and then ended Stanford's season in Game 3 of the NCAA Super Regional at the same site.

• Prior to that season, Stanford had won four straight over the Commodores, including a three-game sweep in Vanderbilt's last visit to The Farm. No. 2 Stanford put up 35 runs in the season-opening set to win by scores of 8-3, 9-5 and 18-5 against No. 10 Vanderbilt.

LAST TIME OUT `

• An 11-3 series-ending rout earned Stanford a series split at #23 Texas on Sunday. The Cardinal began the series with the program's longest shut out on record (since 1959)-a 1-0 win in 12 innings. Freshman Kris Bubic (4.1 innings) sophomore Colton Hock (5.2), and junior Chris Viall (2.0) combined to hold the Longhorns to just five hits. Hock garnered Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week accolades for his relief effort and career-best eight strikeout. Junior Mikey Diekroeger knocked home the winner on an RBI groundout in the 12th.

• The following night, Stanford fell behind 4-0, but chipped away and closed to within 4-3, but could not get the tying run across.

• Texas won the third game, 9-0, but the Cardinal bounced back in a big way on Sunday. Seven players finished with multiple hits, and junior starter Brett Hanewich earned his second win of the season with four strikeouts and just one earned run in 6.1 innings.

• On Tuesday, sophomore Andrew Summerville struck out a career-high nine batters in the longest outing of his career (7.0). Meanwhile, the offense tacked on nine runs to earn the win over Saint Mary's at Sunken Diamond.

Stanford Stats 📊

Four of Stanford's six wins have come against the Top 25, including two on the road. Stanford leads the Pac-12 in fielding percentage (.991) and has the fewest errors (3).
Stanford leads the conference in ERA (2.20), strikeouts (74) and opposing batting average (.191), and has allowed the fewest home runs (2) and walks (16) in the Pac-12.
Stanford has outscored its opponents 20-1, and outhit them, 25-7, in the last two games.

• Stanford won its season-opening series for the first time since a three-game home sweep of Vanderbilt in 2012.

• Junior catcher Alex Dunlap has reached base in all eight games he has played this year.

• Junior shortstop Tommy Edman has played in 98 straight games (started 95 in a row).

• Sophomore Colton Hock was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week, and Stanford has now won the award in each of the first two weeks of the season.

Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week 🖄

• Colton Hock earned the award on Monday after throwing 5.2 scoreless innings in relief in the longest recorded shut out in the program's history (since 1959)—Stanford won 1-0 in 12 innings.

• Hock finished with a career-high eight strikeouts and allowed just three hits at #23 Texas on Thursday.

• Tristan Beck earned the conference honor last week—the first Stanford hurler to win the award since 2013 MLB first overall pick, Mark Appel, did so in May of 2013.

• Beck became the second Stanford freshman to start Opening Day since Mike Mussina in 1988 (teammate Cal Quantrill was the other in 2014).

Klein Field at Sunken Diamond Enhancements 🔤 🏷

• Long regarded as one of the most beautiful college baseball facilities in the country, Klein Field at Sunken Diamond underwent several renovations this offseason.

• Upgraded playing surface—completely replaced, laser-graded flat, features Bermuda grass and top-grade Pennsylvania clay in addition to new irrigation system.

• A modernized and expanded clubhouse now includes a players lounge, dedicated athletic training space and coaches locker room.

• Other developments included the modification and expansion of the ticket office, concession stands and restrooms.

• Head Coach Mark Marquess added 11 freshmen in his latest recruiting class.

• Three pitchers (one lefty), four infielders, three outfielders and a catcher. Six are from the homestate of California, three from Georgia and one apiece from Colorado and Nevada.

Nearly 80 percent of Stanford's starting lineup and rotation return from a year ago.
More than 80 percent of the Cardinal's atbats, runs, hits and RBI from 2015 are back on the roster.

Cal Quantrill and John Hochstatter are both set to return for the 2016 season after both missed the majority of the 2015 campaign due to injury. Each pitcher underwent Tommy John surgery last year.

Preseason All-America 🗾

Juniors Cal Quantrill and Tommy Edman each earned preseason All-America accolades.
Quantrill was name third team Louisville Slugger Preseason All-America accolades from Collegiate Baseball News, and third team preseason All-America accolades from Baseball America.

• Quantrill was a Louisville Slugger and Perfect Game Freshman All-American before his sophomore season was cut short due to injury. Prior to the injury, the Port Hope, Ontario, native was 2-0 with a 1.93 ERA last season. As a freshman, Quantrill was 7-5 with a 2.68 ERA in 17 starts, which included two complete games and 98 strikeouts in 110.2 innings. He earned All-Pac-12 honors and was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Year.

• A math and computational science major, Edman was the only Cardinal to start every game last season and finished with a team-high 29 RBI, 13 doubles, 22 multi-hit games, and was third on the team with a .296 average.
