PURPOSE OF THE CSRE HONORS RESEARCH GRANTS

The CSRE Honors Research Grant are intended to fund expenses related to research and travel undertaken during the summer in preparation for writing an honors thesis either within the Honors Program in Comparative Studies in Race and Ethnicity or the Interdisciplinary Honors Program in Comparative Studies in Race and Ethnicity. CSRE Honors Research Grants are in the amount of \$500.

ELIGIBILITY

CSRE majors in their sophomore or junior year planning to apply for the Honors Program in CSRE or the Interdisciplinary Honors Program in CSRE may apply for the Honors Research Grants. At the time of application, students must also meet the following criteria:

- Students majoring in CSRE must have a grade point average of 3.5 or above in the major at the time of application.
- Non-CSRE majors must have a grade point average of 3.5 or above in their major and an overall grade point average of 3.3 or above at the time of application.
- Juniors (CSRE majors and non-CSRE majors) must have already selected a faculty advisor and a secondary reader who will provide support and final assessment of the thesis and/or project.
- If your project involves the collection of data from human subjects, you must complete the following steps to gain IRB approval.

HOW TO APPLY

Please complete the following CSRE Honors Research Grants Form. In addition, please submit the following supporting documents:

- Unofficial transcript of all academic work completed so far towards the A.B., B.E. or B.S. degree
- Description of the honors thesis project (250 words or fewer)
- Proposed budget describing how funds will be utilized
- One letter of recommendation
- IRB approval notices if required
