### Clinical Research Report Abstract Format

Title	Typed in bold, upper and lower case. State clearly the nature of the study.
Author	Do not include author details in the abstract to allow for blind reviewing.
Background	Brief statement on significance and current state of the problem.
Aim	One sentence statement of the study's specific objective.
Methods	A brief statement of the methods used for this project.
Results	A summary of the results obtained.
Conclusion	A statement of the conclusions. It is not satisfactory to state "the results will be discussed."

### Abstract Submission Process

- Abstracts must be submitted no later than 5pm on January 15, 2016.
- References are not required but may be included.
- A maximum of 500 words excluding title will be accepted.
- Include one learning objective for your presentation.
- Include a copy of your updated curriculum vitae.
