

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Berryessa Creek Improvements

WHAT: A larger, wider, straighter channel is being constructed in Berryessa Creek just south of Abel St. Bridge to remove bottlenecks in the creek that cause periodic flooding. In mid-August concrete was poured to line the bottom and lower sides of the new creek bed. Future concrete pours will complete the internal walls and top of the new creek structure.



GENERAL IMPACTS: Activities through December may include the following: pile driving (vibrating metal sheets into the ground), demolition noise, vehicle warning beepers, dust, flood lights, idling diesel engines, and possible Sunday and night work. *Please Note: Local levee trails will be closed until further notice, follow local pedestrian detour signage (See Attachment).*

WHY: Work is occurring at an aggressive pace to make long-term flood control improvements associated with the preparation of the rail corridor for the planned BART Silicon Valley Project. Work in the creek must be complete by the end of October to comply with local regulations.

PROJECT INFORMATION: This notice serves as a general update for all anticipated impacts. Sunday and night work are **not** typical activities but may occur infrequently to complete the project.
