Greg,

Enron sent to me yesterday a fax requesting a meeting sometime on December 10 or 11 to discuss a BIT-related dispute that it is having in Argentina. Enron stated that they had established a subsidiary which won a contract to provide potable and wastewater services in the Buenos Aires district, but that the government has not met its obligations and that Enron is now prepared to submit the dispute to international arbitration. Could you please reply with your fax number so that I can forward Enron's fax to you?

Enron has asked if Treasury can attend the meeting. Frankly, I am not yet sure what the rank of USTR participation will be though I understand that Enron will be meeting with State's DAS for the Southern Cone. I was hoping that you could run this issue through Treasury and help determine who might want to attend. I will forward the details of the meeting time and venue as soon as I have them.
