Written certification by the Chair of the Department that applicant: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. will be under his or her direction b. will not be permitted to practice medicine unless incident to and necessary part of the applicant's duties c. will be accountable to the Department Chair or Division Chief for the specialty d. will be proctored as for any other new faculty member e. cannot serve in a supervisory role 	5. Oversight <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Must be under the direction of the department b. Supervised by the staff of the medical school's medical center c. Engage in the practice of medicine strictly under the jurisdiction of the School of Medicine and under the direct supervision of a physician licensed in California
6. The Dean must "demonstrate" that the applicant has the necessary qualifications, confirmed by the recruitment procedures followed by the medical school for that applicant.	6.

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<p>7. Term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. A certificate of registration is good for one year, renewable twice b. The Dean may request renewal at the beginning of the third year by demonstrating continued progress toward licensure, in which case the Board may, in its discretion, extend the registration for a two-year period to facilitate licensure. 	<p>7. Term</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Appointment period is for a maximum of 3 years b. Renewed on an annual basis c. Appointment only to one medical school and only one approval at a time
<p>8. The registrant may only practice as full-time faculty as prescribed and may not have a private practice of medicine.</p>	<p>8. No practice without direct supervision of a licensed physician.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Neither the registrant nor the institution may bill for services b. Any orders countersigned by a licensed physician c. Registrant may not receive any compensation for clinical services
<p>9. The registrant must wear a visible name tag containing the title “visiting professor” or “visiting faculty member”</p>	<p>9. The registrant must wear a name tag containing the words: “visiting fellow”</p>
<p>10. The institution at which the registrant is providing services must obtain a signed acknowledgement from every patient to which the registrant provides services that the patient understands that the services are provided by a person who does not hold a physician’s and surgeon’s certificate but is qualified to participate in the special program as visiting professor or faculty member.</p>	<p>10. Registrant must not hold himself out as possessing any type of license to practice medicine in California.</p>
