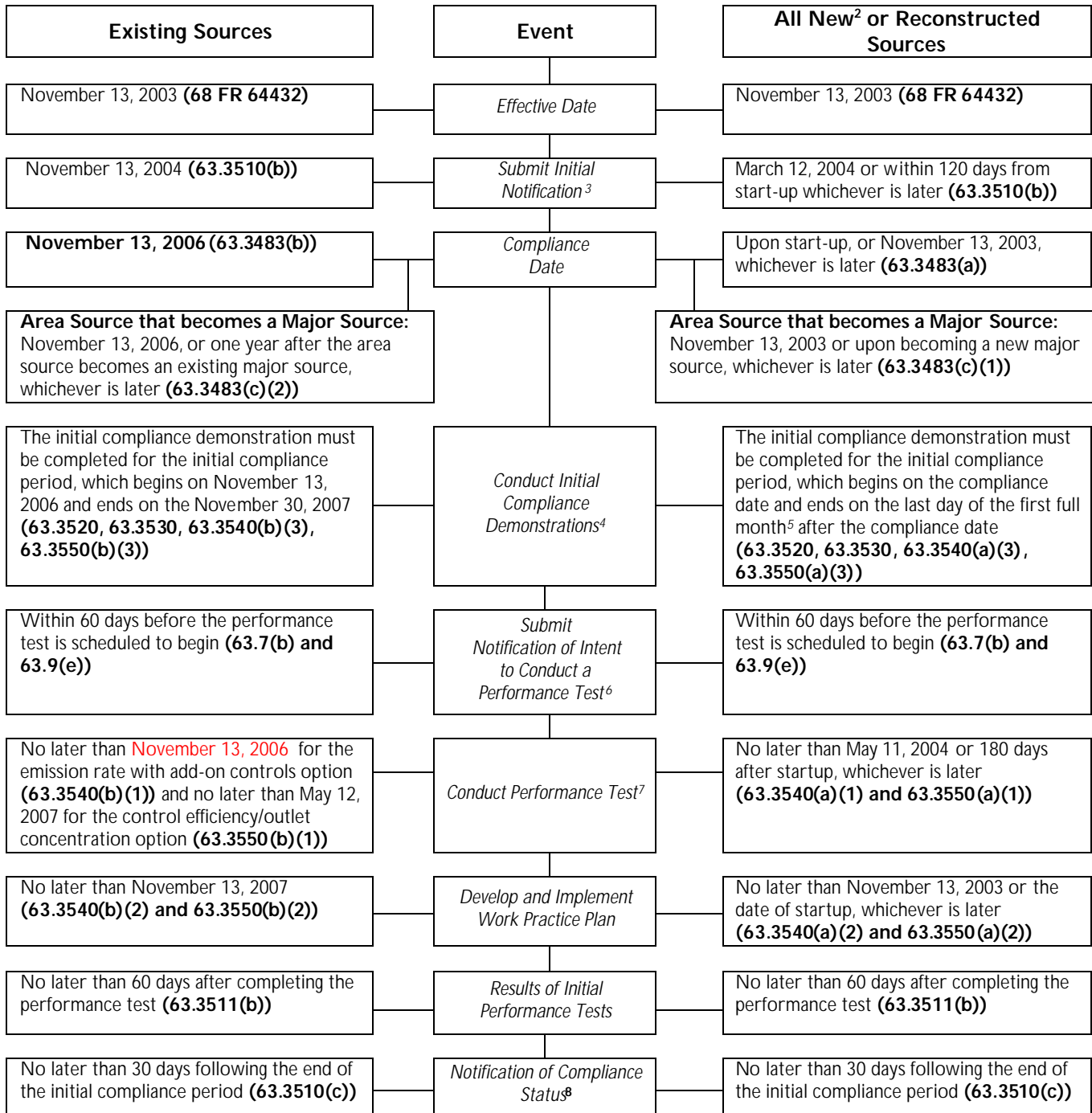

¹ This timeline does not take into account special situations such as compliance extensions.

² New affected source: an affected source that the construction or reconstruction of which is begun after January 14, 2003 **(63.3482(c))**.

³ A title V permit application may be used in lieu of the initial notification, provided that the information specified in 63.9(b) is included, the State has an approved part 70 operating permit program, and the State has received delegation of authority from EPA.

⁴ Applies to all compliance options: compliant coatings option, emission rate without add-on controls option, emission rate with add-on controls option, and control efficiency/outlet concentration option.

⁵ If the compliance date occurs on any day other than the first day of a month, then the initial compliance period extends through the end of that month plus the next 12 months.

⁶ Applies to emission rate with add-on controls option and control efficiency/outlet concentration option only.

⁷ Performance tests must be performed for each capture system and add-on control device, except for solvent recovery systems. For solvent recovery systems, the first material balance must be initiated.

⁸ The initial compliance period begins on the compliance date and ends on the last day of the twelfth month after the compliance date **(63.3520, 63.3530, or 63.3540(a)(3) and (b)(3), or 63.3550(a)(3) and (b)(3))**. **If the compliance date occurs on any day other than the first day of the month, then the initial compliance period extends through the end of that month plus the next 12 months.**

⁹ The initial semiannual report must cover the period beginning on the day after the end of the initial compliance period and ends on June 30 or December 31, whichever date is the first date following the end of the initial compliance period. **(63.3520(a)(1))**

¹⁰ If you are subject to title V operating permit regulations under 40 CFR part 70 or 40 CFR part 71, and if your permitting authority has established dates for submitting semiannual reports under these regulations, you may submit the first and subsequent semiannual compliance reports with your title V reports.
